Re: Petition 5443 — Edith Flaim.

Returning herewith petition of Edith Flaim (5443) requesting permission to maintain posts and beam barricade in the public alley rear of 582 Dumfries to protect her garage and fence from damage.

Encroachment consists of several posts and beams placed horizontally ranging from 12 to 18 inches in height and being approximately two feet into the alley. This public alley is twenty feet in width and at this point is in excess of twenty-three feet in width from the beam to the garage located on the opposite side of the alley, therefore causing no inconvenience to the adjacent owner using the alley to get into the garage.

The Environmental Protection and Maintenance Department has no objection to the placement and maintenance of these posts and recommends granting of the petition provided petitioner assumes any liability for any claim resulting from this grant.
