FOURTH, That if at any time in the future, the owners of any lot abutting on said vacated alley shall request the removal and/or relocation of any existing poles or other utilities in said easement, such owners, upon whose property the poles or other utilities are located pay all costs incidental to such removal and/or relocation, unless such charges are waived by the utility owners.
