By Council Member Cleveland:

Resolved, That all that part of East Grand Boulevard between Cameron and the Chrysler Freeway described as:

A parcel of land 75 feet in perpendicular width being part of East Grand Boulevard of "Subdivision of Lot 3" of Subdivision of ¼ Section 58, 10,000 A.T., City of Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan, as recorded in Liber 17 of Plats, page 54, Wayne County Records, and being described as: Commencing at the Southeast corner of Lot 41 of said "Subdivision of Lot 3"; thence S 64°-01'-20" W along the Southerly lot line 3.45 feet to the point of beginning of this description; thence S 64°-01'-20" W along the Southerly line of Lots 41 thru 46 inclusive, 266.55 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 46; thence S 26°-00' E along the Easterly line of Cameron Avenue 21.05 feet; thence on the arc of a curve to the right 136.70 feet (radius of 358.00 feet, delta of 21°-52'-39" and chord bearing N 87°-52'-40" E 133.40 feet); thence N 64°01'-20" E 108.50 feet along the centerline of East Grand Boulevard, 150 feet wide, to the Westerly line of relocated Richmond Avenue (60 feet wide); thence along said line N 11°-32'45" E 7.20 feet; thence along said line on the arc of a curve to the left 78.98 feet (radius of 170.00 feet, delta of 26°-37'-09", chord bearing N 01°-25'45" W 76.17 feet to the point of beginning.

Be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street and is hereby converted into a public easement of the full width of the street, which easement shall be subject to the following covenants and agreements, uses, reservations and regulations, which shall be observed by the owners of the lots abutting on said street and by their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever to wit:

FIRST, said owners hereby grant to and for the use of the public an easement or right of way over said vacated public street hereinabove described for the purposes of maintaining, installing, repairing, removing, or replacing pub-

lic utilities such as water mains, sewers, gas lines or mains, telephone, electric light conduits or poles or things usually placed or installed in a public street in the City of Detroit, with the right to ingress and egress at any time to and over said easement for the purpose above set forth,

SECOND, said owners for their heirs and assigns further agree that no buildings or structures of any nature whatsoever including but not limited to concrete slabs or driveways, retaining or partition walls (except necessary line fence) shall be built or placed upon said easement, nor any change or surface grade made, without prior approval by the Department of Public Works,

THIRD, that if at any time in the future the owners of any lot abutting on said vacated street shall request the removal and/or relocation of any existing poles or other utilities in said easement, such owners, upon whose property the poles or other utilities are located shall pay all costs incidental to such removal and/or relocation, unless such charges are waived by the utility owners,

PROVIDED FURTHER, that if any utility located or to be located in said property shall break or be damaged as a result of any action on the part of the petitioner or assigns (by way of illustration but not limitation), such as storage of excessive weights of materials or construction not in accordance with Section 2, mentioned above, then in such event the petitioner or assigns shall be liable for all costs incidental to the repair of such broken or damaged utility.
