Resolved, That the Department of City
Engineering be and is hereby author-
ized and directed to issue permit to
J. James Hasenau, owner of the prop-
erty adjoining the alleys herein con-
cerned, to extend the closing of 20 feet
wide alley between Patton, Plymouth
and Braile on temporary basis for a
period not exceeding five (5) years from
April 1, 1988 in accordance with the
Community and Economic Development
Department, Plan No. A-3629.

Provided, that petitioner shall be sub-
ject to any tax which may be levied
against it pursuant to law with regards
to such use of public property, and
further;

Provided, petitioner first furnished an
Agreement, in form approved by the
Law Department, saving and protecting
the City of Detroit harmless from any
and all claims, damages or expenses
that may arise by reason of the issuance
of said permit, and providing for the
faithful performance by the grantee of
the terms hereof, and files same with
the Finance Department, and further;

Provided, that said permit shall be
issued only after a certified copy of this
resolution has been duly recorded in
the office of the Wayne County Register
of Deeds, by and at the permittee's
expense, and further;

Provided, that no building or other
structure is constructed in said alley;
that petitioner shall observe the rules
and regulations of the Department of
Public Works, and further subject to the
following provisions;

The City of Detroit regains all rights
and interests in the area herein tem-
porarily closed;

The City and all utility companies re-
tain their rights to establish, maintain
and service any utilities in said area of
temporarily closed alley, and further;

Provided, that all the expiration of
said permit, all obstructions therein shall
be removed at the expense of the
grantee, and the public property affected
shall be restored to a condition satis-
factory to the Department of Public
Works be and at the permittee's ex-
pense, and further;

Provided, that grantee acquires no
implied nor other privileges hereunder
not expressly stated herein, and further;

Provided, this resolution is revocable
at the will, whim or caprice of the City
Council.
