sion and other interested City Depart-  
ments have been contacted and there  
are no objections to the extension of  
time.

After careful consideration of all the  
factors involved, it is the recommenda-  
tion of the Community & Economic De-  
velopment Department that the tempo-  
rary closing of the alley, as shown on  
Plan #2932 be extended for an addi-  
tional five (5) year period subject to all  
the provisions as they apply to the ex-  
tension of a temporary closing.

Resolved, That the Department of City  
Engineering be and is hereby authorized  
and directed to issue permit to Liberty  
Temple Church, owner of the property  
adjoining the alley herein concerned,  
to extend the closing 20 feet wide alley  
south of E. Seven Mile at Russell on  
temporary basis for a period not exceed-  
ing five (5) years from April 30, 1988 in  
accordance with the Community and  
Economic Development Department Plan  
No. 2932.

Provided, That petitioner shall be sub-  
ject to any tax which may be levied  
against it pursuant to law with regards

to such use of public property, and  
further;

Provided, Petitioner first furnishes an  
Agreement, in form approved by the  
Law Department, saving and protecting  
the City of Detroit harmless from any  
and all claims, damages or expenses  
that may arise by reason of the issu-  
ance of said permit, and providing for  
the faithful performance by the grantee  
of the terms hereof, and files same with  
the Finance Department, and further;

Provided, That said permit shall be  
issued only after a certified copy of this  
resolution has been duly recorded in  
the office of the Wayne County Regis-  
ter of Deeds, by and at the permittee's  
expense, and further;

Provided, That no building or other  
structure is constructed in said alley,  
that petitioner shall observe the rules  
and regulations of the Department of  
Public Works, and further subject to the  
following provisions;

The City of Detroit regains all rights  
and interests in the area herein tem-  
porarily closed;

The City and all utility companies re-  
tain their rights to establish, maintain  
and service any utilities in said area of  
temporarily closed alley, and further;

Provided, That at the expiration of  
said permit, all obstructions therein shall  
be removed at the expense of the  
grantee, and the public property affected  
shall be restored to a condition satis-  
factory to the Department of Public  
Works by and at the permittee's ex-  
pense, and further;

Provided, That grantee acquires no  
implied nor other privileges hereunder  
not expressly stated herein, and further;

Provided, This resolution is revocable  
at the will, whim or caprice of the City  
Council.
