Honorable City Council:

Re: Petition #2088 — Meadows Products of Michigan Inc. to renew Franklin Street closing for one year from June 30, 1988.

Investigation disclosed that the grant for the temporary closing of the above described street has expired and the petitioner now wishes an extension of time. There have been no complaints since this street closing has been in effect and no change in the conditions.

The Department of Transportation, Planning and Traffic Engineering Division and other interested City Departments have been contacted and there are no objections to the extension of time.

After careful consideration of all the factors involved, it is the recommendation of the Community & Economic Development Department that the temporary closing of the street, as shown on Plan #600-722 be extended for an additional one (1) year period subject to all the provisions as they apply to the extension of a temporary closing.

Resolved, That the Department of City Engineering be and is hereby authorized and directed to issue permit to Meadows Products, owner of the property adjoining the street herein concerned, to extend the closing of Franklin St. on temporary basis for a period not exceeding one (1) year from June 30, 1988 in accordance with the Community and Economic Development Department Plan No. 600-722.

Provided, That petitioner shall be subject to any tax which may be levied against it pursuant to law with regards to such use of public property, and further;

Provided, petitioner first furnishes an Agreement, in form approved by the Law Department, saving and protecting the City of Detroit harmless from any and all claims, damages or expenses that may arise by reason of the issuance of said permit, and providing for the faithful performance by the grantee of the terms hereof, and files same with the Finance Department, and further;

Provided, That said permit shall be issued only after a certified copy of this resolution has been duly recorded in the office of the Wayne County Register of Deeds, by and at the permittee's expense, and further;

Provided, That no building or other structure is constructed in said alley; that petitioner shall observe the rules

and regulations of the Department of Public Works, and further subject to the following provisions:

The City of Detroit regains all rights and interests in the area herein temporarily closed;

The City and all utility companies retain their rights to establish, maintain and service any utilities in said area of temporarily closed alley, and further;

Provided, That all the expiration of said permit, all obstructions therein shall be removed at the expense of the grantee, and the public property affected shall be restored to a condition satisfactory to the Department of Public Works be and at the permittee's expense, and further;

Provided, That grantee acquires no implied nor other privileges hereunder not expressly stated herein, and further;

Provided, This resolution is revocable at the will, whim or caprice of the City Council.
