Honorable City Council:

Re: Cobo Hall Expansion Project, Property transfers, and the granting of easements to the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT).

A contract (dated November 13, 1987) was made between the City and the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) to facilitate the expansion of Cobo Hall, the reconstruction of parts of Highway US-10 (the Lodge Freeway), ramps, pumps, lighting, and other related work.

Part of this contract (MDOT #87-0319) required the "as built" exchange of properties and the grant of easements within parcels controlled by the City, MDOT, and the Downtown Development Authority (DDA).

The City has obtained approval to grant an easement to MDOT within a parcel controlled by the DDA (said parcel being E. of Second, and S. of Congress; aka "Easement Parcel C"; formerly part of the First Street Properties Corporation for the proposed Hotel project, which was never built). The board of Directors of the DDA gave their approval to the City on July 10, 1990.

Drawings and legal descriptions were submitted (by the City Engineering Department) to MDOT for review and approval. The Real Estate Division of MDOT has approved these documents, and is in the process of conveyancing to the City.

This is an outline of the legal descriptions contained in the attached resolution:

(Note: It is necessary to authorize the Finance Director to executive a quitclaim deed to transfer this parcel to MDOT).

III. Grant of Easements to MDOT for

A. Location: John C. Lodge Fwy., and Larned St. ramp through Cobo Conference Center to Washington Blvd.; aka "(Easement) Parcel A".

"(Easement) Parcel A". B. Location: John C. Lodge ramp, W. of Second Ave.; aka "(Easement) Parcel 8"

C. Location: E. of Second, S. of Congress; (Part of First Street Properties Corp., approved to the City for grant to MDOT by DDA) aka "(Easement) Parcel C"

D. Location: Pump House — S. of Congress, W. of Second, aka (Easement) Parcel D".

Lodge Freeway), including the connecting ramps and streets, redesigned to integrate the highway system into the changed environment caused by the expansion of Cobo Hall; together with other related work; all within the project boundary of "Cobo Conference Center" (described below in this resolution); and

Whereas, Part of this contract (MDOT #87-0319) required the "as built" exchange of properties and the grant of easements for highway purposes within parcels controlled by the City, MDOT, and the Downtown Development Autohrity (DDA); and

Whereas, The City has obtained approval to grant an easement to MDOT within a parcel from the Board of Directors for the Downtown Development Authority, a Michigan public authority and body corporate, whose address is 600 First National Building, Detroit, MI 48226 (the "Board") by Board action on July 10, 1990; therefore be it

S.59°51'24'W., along said southerly line of Congress Street, 35.40 feet to the point of beginning; thence S.59°51'24'W., along said southerly line beginning; of Congress Street 51.05 feet; thence S.30°09'42"E., 100.39 feet; thence N.49°08'01"E., along the high edge of the slope paving berm, 66.15 feet; thence N.30°09'42"W., along the westerly fascia of the truck ramp, 54.08 feet to a point of curve; thence 37.70 feet along said fascia of truck ramp being the arc of a curve concave to the southwest, with a radius of 48.38 feet, a delta of 44°39'20" and a long chord of 36.76 feet which bears N.52°28'16"W., to the point of beginning containing 5800 feet or 0.1331 acres more or less.

The above description is for access and maintenance of the Lodge Freeway Pump Station D-08 of 82111 as detailed on drawings 1 thru 11 of Michigan Department of Transportation Job number 26062A. The aerial rights of said easement are limited to the underside of that portion of the Cobo Center Helix that extends out over the easement area, and
