Honorable City Council:

Re: Petition No. 930. Mariners' Inn,
Alley to Vacation, northerly half of
the north-south public alley in the
block bounded by Second, Cass,
Henry and Ledyard.

Petition No. 930 of "Mariners' Inn — A
Shelter and Treatment Center for the
Homeless" requests the outright vaca-
tion of the northerly half of the north-
south public alley, 20 feet wide, in the
block bounded by Second Boulevard,
Cass Avenue, Henry and Ledyard
Streets (purpose: to complete a building
expansion project).

The petition was approved by the
Community and Economic Development
Department and referred to the City
Engineering Department for investiga-
tion and report. This is our report:

Satisfactory arrangements have been
made with the Detroit Edison Company,
the Ameritech Company (a/k/a Michigan
Bell Telephone Company), and the Water
and Sewerage Department — Sewer
Services Section.

All other involved city departments and
privately-owned utility companies have
reported no objections to the public alley
vacation.

An appropriate resolution is attached
for consideration by your Honorable
Body.

"Plat of the Subdivision, Block 79 and

Liber 1, Pages 92 and 93, Plats, Wayne
County Records;

Be and the same is hereby vacated as
a public (alley) right-of-way to become
part and parcel of the abutting property;
and be it further

Resolved, That the City Clerk shall
within 30 days record a certified copy of
this resolution with the Wayne County
Register of Deeds.
