Re: Request for Final Plat Approval, Virginia Park Estates Subdivision.

The Planning & Development Department (P&DD) respectfully requests City Council approval of the Final Plat for the Virginia Park Estates Subdivision, Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan. Enclosed please find twelve (12) copies of the Final Plat.

Background information

Virginia Park Estates Subdivision is located on a 17.30 acre site bounded generally by Virginia Park Avenue on the north, Poe Avenue on the east, Pallister Avenue on the south, and Rosa Parks Avenue on the west. Virginia Park Estates will contain 45 single family residential lots, a lighted and landscaped boulevard entranceway, two public parks, and perimeter fencing and landscaping. The parks and other common areas will be maintained by a home owner's association established in conjunction with the development of the subdivision.

Previous Actions

The Virginia Park Estates Subdivision Plat was reviewed by the Detroit City Planning Commission on November 10, 1993. The City Council approved related street and alley vacations on November 17, 1993. Tentative approval of the Preliminary Plat was granted on December 1, 1993 and final approval of the Preliminary Plat on September 15, 1994, both under Article II of Chapter 51 of the Detroit City Code which sets forth the procedure for processing subdivision

Final Plat Review by Departments

The plat was then referred back to P&DD for preparation of the Final Plat map according to guidelines set forth by the Wayne County Register of Deeds.

Upon completion of the Final Plat drawings, the Plat was redistributed to involved City departments including the City Treasurer and the Wayne County Treasurer where the Plat was reviewed for outstanding tax liabilities.

Upon clearance by the City of Detroit and Wayne County Treasurers respectively, the Final Plat was referred to the Wayne County Department of Public Service for their review and approval under the Detroit City Code and Sections 112-118 of Public Act 288, State of Michigan Subdivision Control Act of 1967, as amended.

All involved City and County departments have completed their review, and state no objection to said plat. Please see the documentation attached with this

Completion of Improvements, Monuments & Irons

In order to obtain approval of the Final Plat, Chapter 51 of the Detroit City Code requires the City to inspect, approve, and accept 1) all subdivision infrastructure improvements such as roads, sewers, and street lights and 2) all surveying irons and monuments. If these improvements are not yet completed or installed, the municipality must dedicate funds for said installation and inspection.

Please note that 1) the Virginia Park Estates infrastructure improvements are entirely complete, inspected, and approved by all appropriate City Departments as reflected by their above referenced approval statements and 2) all surveying irons and monuments have been installed by the engineering firm of Warner, Cantrell & Padmos, Inc. and inspected by the City of Detroit City Engineers Office.

Recommended Action

The Planning & Development Department therefore recommends City Council approval of the Virginia Park Estates Final Plat in accordance with the Detroit City Code, Sections 51-2-4 & 51-2-5 and Section 167 of Public Act 288, State of Michigan Subdivision Control Act of 1967, as amended, being MCL, Section 560-167. An appropriate resolution is attached for consideration by the City Council.

Acting as Proprietor, the Planning & Development Department respectfully requests that the City Clerk's Office place this matter on the agenda of the City Council for review and approval at the earliest opportunity.

The Planning & Development Department (P&DD) respectfully requests City Council recertification of the Final Plat for the Virginia Park Estates Subdivision. Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan. Enclosed please find twelve (12) copies of the Final Plat as revised July 1, 1995.

Background Information

Virginia Park Estates Subdivision Final Plat was approved by the City Council on May 18, 1995 and certified by the City Clerk's Office under Article II of Chapter 51 of the Detroit City Code which sets forth the procedure for processing subdivision plats.

In a subsequent review by the Wayne County Plat Board, an omission was discovered in regard to the number of proprietors listed on the Virginia Park Estates Plat. The Plat listed only the City of Detroit as "Proprietor" omitting C-V Partnership, the developer, and The Beneicke Group, Inc., the builder of the subdivision. Both these entities have property interests in the proposed Virginia Park Estates Subdivision and should have been included prior to City Council approval.

Omissions Corrected

As shown on the Plat Map on file in the City Clerk's Office, the Planning & Development Department has corrected the aforementioned omissions by adding C-V Partnership and The Beneicke Group, Inc. to the official Plat Map as "Proprietors" along with the City of Detroit.

All Other Clearances & Approvals Still in Effect

Please note that clearances from the Detroit City Treasurer and the Wayne County Treasurer are still valid as are reviews and approvals from all involved City of Detroit departments and the Wayne County Department of Public Service. Please see the official Plat Map and documentation on file in the City Clerk's Office.

Further, all Virginia Park Estates infrastructure improvements are entirely complete, inspected, and approved by all appropriate City Departments as reflected by the above referenced documentation. All surveying irons and monuments have been installed by the engineering firm of Warner, Cantrell & Padmos, Inc. and inspected by the City of Detroit City Engineers Office.
