Petition No. 1972 of McDonald's Corporation, et all requests the conversion of the north-south public alley, 15 feet wide, in the block bounded by Woodward and Bauman Avenues, W. Seven Mile Road, and Larchwood Avenue into a private easement for public utilities.

The requested conversion was approved by the Planning and Development Department, Solid Waste Division - DPW, and Traffic Engineering Division - DPW. The petition was referred to the City Engineering Division - DPW for investigation of the City Engineering Division - DPW for investigation tion (utility review) and report. This is our report:

The petitioner(s) plan to remove the paved alley return entrances (into W. Seven Mile Road and Larchwood Avenue). The petitioner(s) shall pay all incidental removal costs whenever discontinuance of use makes removal necessary.

City departments and privately owned utility companies have reported no objections to the conversion of public rights-ofway into a private easement for public utilities. Provisions protecting utility installations are part of the resolution.

RESOLVED, All of the north-south public alley, 15 feet wide, in the block bounded by Woodward and Bauman Avenues, W. Seven Mile Road, and Larchwood Avenue lying westerly of and abutting the west line of Lot 47; also lying easterly of and abutting the east line of Lots 48 thru 51 of "Ivanhoe Addition Subdivision of Lot 2 of Peter Dixon's Subdivision of East Half of Southwest Quarter of Section 2, Town I South, Range 11 East, Greenfield ('Township]," City of Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan as recorded in Liber 18, Page 70, Plats, Wayne County Records;

Be and the same is hereby vacated as a public alley and is hereby converted into a private easement for public utilities of the full width of the alley, which easement shall be subject to the following covenants and agreements, uses, reservations and regulations, which shall be observed by the owners of the lots abutting on said alley and by their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever to wit:

FIRST, said owners hereby grant to and for the use of the public an easement or right-of-way over said vacated public alley herein above described for the purposes of maintaining, installing, repairing, removing, or replacing public utilities such as water mains, sewers, gas lines or mains, telephone, electric light conduits or poles or things usually placed or installed in a public alley in the City of Detroit, with the right to ingress and egress at any time to and over said easement for the purpose above set forth.

SECOND, said utility easement or rightof-way in and over said vacated alley herein above described shall be forever accessible to the maintenance and inspection forces of the utility companies, or those specifically authorized by them, for the purpose of inspecting, installing, maintaining, repairing, removing, or replacing any sewer, conduit, water main, gas line or main, telephone or light pole or any utility facility placed or installed in the utility easement or right-of-way. The utility companies shall have the right to cross or use the driveways and yards of the adjoining properties for incress and acress at any

time to and over said utility easement with any necessary equipment to perform the above mentioned tasks, with the understanding that the utility companies shall use due care in such crossing or use, and that any property damaged by the utility companies, other than that specifically prohibited by this resolution, shall be restored to a satisfactory condition,

THIRD, said owners for their heirs and assigns further agree that no buildings or structures of any nature whatsoever including, but not limited to, retaining or partition walls, (excepting therefrom the appurtenances shown on the plan by Lautzenheiser Associates Architects 620 S. Dorchester, Royal Oak, MI 48067; phone: 810-399-2216; fax: 810-399-2774; .A.A. #9601; drawing title: "McDonald's -Detroit Region, Street Address: Woodward and 7 Mile, City - Detroit, State- Michigan, County - Wayne, Site Location Code No. 021-1416; sheet No. C-1; date drawn: 2/8/95; Revision 1, date 2/12/95, entitled: 'Added public alley to be vacated'; Revision 2, date 2/21/96, entitled: 'Moved building forward of alley'; said installations shall be subject to the review and approval of the Fire Marshal and Buildings and Safety Engineering Department, if necessary) shall be built or placed upon said easement, nor change of surface grade made, without prior approval of the City Engineering Division - DPW,
FOURTH, that if the owners of any lots

abutting on said vacated alley shall request the removal and/or relocation of any existing poles or other utilities in said easement, such owners, shall pay all costs incidental to such removal and/or relocation, unless such charges are

waived by the utility owners,

FIFTH, that if any utility located in said property shall break or be damaged as a result of any action on the part of said owners or assigns (by way of illustration but not limitation) such as storage of excessive weights of materials or construction not in accordance with Section 3, mentioned above, then in such event said owners or assigns shall be liable for all costs incidental to the repair of such broken or damaged utility; and further

PROVIDED, That when it becomes necessary to remove the paved alley return(s) at their entrance(s) (into W. Seven Mile Road and/or Larchwood Avenue), such removal and construction of new curb and sidewalk shall be done under city permit inspection according to City Engineering Division - DPW specifications with all costs borne by the "McDonald's" owner(s), their heirs or assigns; and fur-

PROVIDED, That the City Clerk shall within 30 days record a certified copy of this resolution with the Wayne County Register of Deeds.
