
Re: Shopper's World (#3209), request to convert Anvil Ave. detween Lappin and Pfent Avenues into a private easement (Recommend Approval).

Be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street and is hereby converted into a private easement for public utilities of the full width of the street, which easement shall be subject to the following covenants and agreements, uses, reservations and regulations, which shall be observed by the owners of the lots abutting on said street and by their heirs. executors, administrators and assigns, forever to wit:

First, Said owners hereby grant to and for the use of the public an easement or right-of-way over said vacated public street herein above described for the purposes of maintaining, installing, repairing, removing, or replacing public utilities such as water mains, sewers, gas lines or mains, telephone, electric light conduits or poles or things usually placed or installed in a public street in the City of Detroit, with the right to ingress and egress at any time to and over said easement for the purpose above set forth.

Second, Said utility easement or rightof-way in and over said vacated street herein above described shall be forever accessible to the maintenance and nspection forces of the utility companies. or those specifically authorized by them, or the purpose of inspecting, installing, naintaining, repairing, removing, or eplacing any sewer, conduit, water main, ans line or main, telephone or light pole or any utility facility placed or installed in the itility easement or right-of-way. The utility companies shall have the right to cross or use the driveways and yards of the adjoining properties for ingress and egress at any time to and over said utility easement vith any necessary equipment to perform he above mentioned tasks, with the inderstanding that the utility companies shall use due care in such crossing or use. and that any property damaged by the utily companies, other than that specifically rohibited by this resolution, shall be astored to a satisfactory condition.

Third, Said owners or their heirs and asigns further agree that no buildings or tructures of any nature whatsoever inluding, but not limited to, concrete slabs r driveways, retaining or partition wails. except necessary line fence; said fence nd gate installations shall be subject to to review and approval of the Fire

Marshal and Buildings and Safety Engineering Department, if necessary) shall be built or placed upon said easement, nor change of surface grade made, without prior approval of the City the City Engineering Division-DPW.

Fourth. That if the owners of any tots abutting on said vacated street shall request the removal ancior relocation of any existing poles or other utilities in said easement, such owners, shall pay all costs incidental to such removal and/or relocation, unless such charges are waived by the utility owners.

Fifth, That if any utility located in said property shall preak or be damaged as a result of any action on the part of said owners or assigns (by way of illustration but not limitation) such as storage of excessive weights of materials or construction not in accordance with Section 3, mentioned above, then in such event said owners or assigns shall be flable for all costs incidental to the repair of such broken or damaged utility; and further

Provided. That if it becomes necessary to remove the paved street returns at their entrances (into Lappin and/or Pfent Avenues), such removal and construction of new curb and signwark shall be done under dry permit and nispection according to Oity Engineering Division-DPW specifications of the permit dations with all costs borne by "Shopper's World, Incil, the adulting bluner(s), their heirs or assigns; and further Provided.
