Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

On behalf of Equilon Enterprises, LLC, EnecoTech Midwest, Inc. (EnecoTech) is requesting your approval to install up to seven groundwater monitoring wells in the right-of-ways of Michigan Avenue, Eleventh Street, and a public alley located in the vicinity of the Shell Service Station at 1715 Michigan Avenue in Detroit. Parson's Engineering Science previously submitted a request to install five monitoring wells at this Shell facility (Petition No. 4004); however, these monitoring wells were not installed.

EnecoTech proposes to install two monitoring wells in the south right-of-way and one monitoring well in the north right-of-way of Michigan Avenue; one monitoring well in both the east and west right-of-ways of Eleventh Street, and one monitoring well in the public alley located south of the Shell facility. These monitoring wells will be installed to collect soil and groundwater samples surrounding the Shell facility, as required by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality. A site map with the proposed monitoring well location is attached.

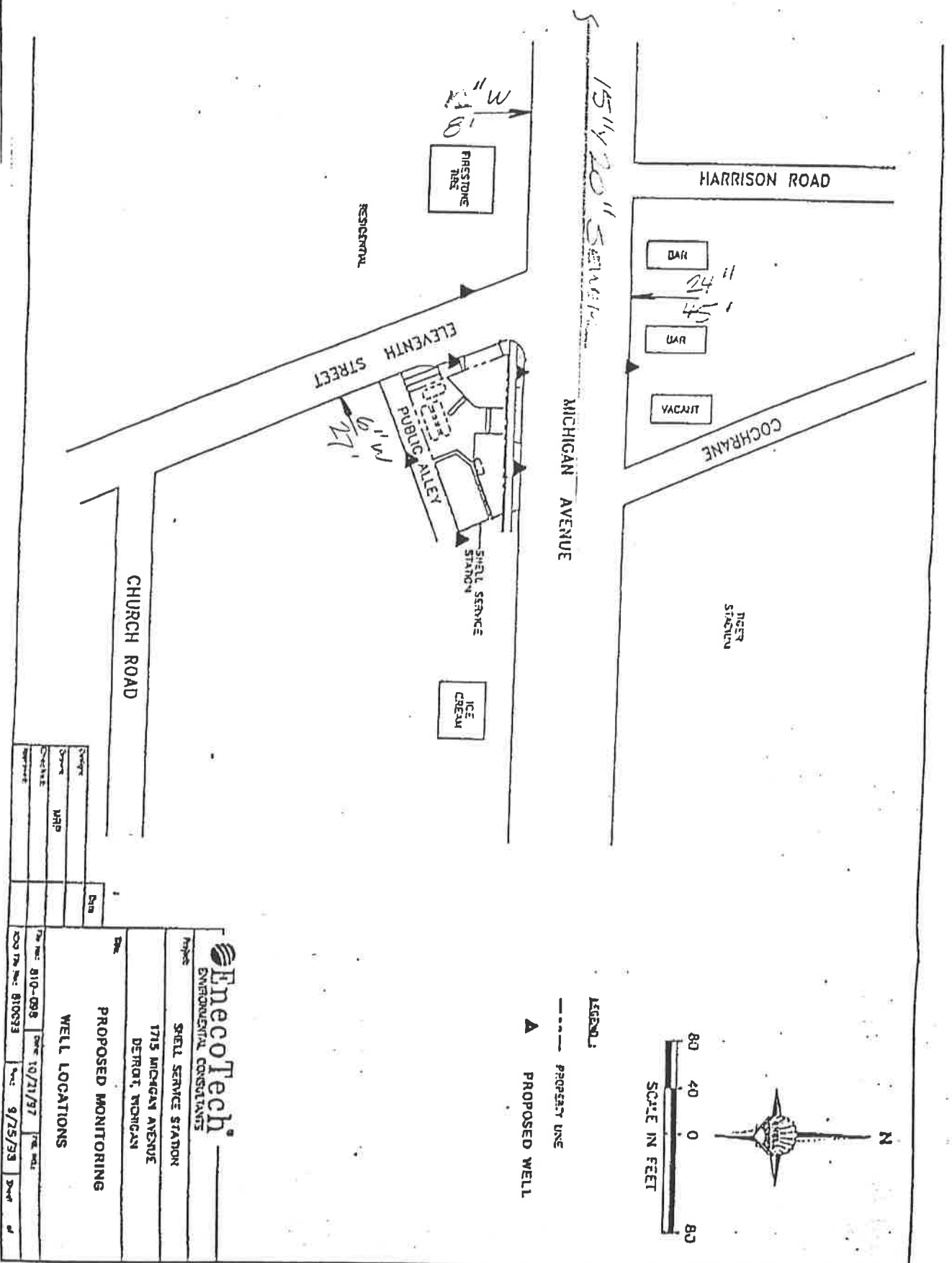
