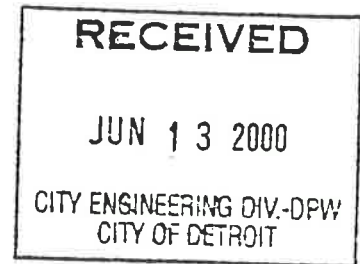

Dear Respectable City Council,

We are **A Non-Profit Religious Organization** working in the city of Detroit. We want to draw your attention to some major problems we are having as a result of the alley that is located behind our **establishment-19800 Van Dyke Road**.

People are using this alley as a means to **deface & damage** our property. Some of *the "nasty" & "downright criminal"* things we've encountered are as follows:

- People urinating on our property
- People leaving their feces on our property
- People throwing bottles & breaking them on our property
- People throwing trash on our property
- People using & discarding needles on our property
- People smashing our car windows (several times) & throwing rocks at them

These are not rare incidents. **They happen on a daily basis!** Some of us at this property have witnessed these acts and have warned some of the perpetrators, but to no avail.

This alley is blocked on the end farthest from our building, but is not blocked in the area right behind our building.

This alley serves as a means for **ill & corrupt behavior**, resulting in our property being damaged. It also creates an **unsafe environment** for those who live in and/or frequent this area.

We are requesting the city's permission to place a fence across the alley **to prevent destruction of private property & to make a safer Detroit**.

Your **prompt response** would be **appreciated**. Summer is almost here & we've seen that a rise in temperature brings a rise in these types of unwanted incidents, which look bad for this neighborhood & the City of Detroit.
