Re: Proposed vacation and relocation of public alley

PETITION TO VACATE AND RELOCATE ALLEY

This is a petition to vacate the alley running north-west/south-east along the property leased by National Heritage Academies, at 1091 Alter Road, Detroit MI (the "Property"). The alley is parallel to and south of Alter Road and parallel to and north of Ashland Avenue. We are submitting this Petition by National Heritage Academies, as Tenant and the Archdiocese of Detroit as Owner of the Property, on behalf of Merit Academy, a public charter school academy located on Alter Road in Detroit. The School is currently undergoing a two million dollar expansion and needs to vacate and relocate the alley to develop parking which is necessary for the operation of the school. This expansion will bring revenue into the city, increase educational choices available to area students and residents, provide for new jobs, and improve the general makeup of the surrounding area.

The developer would like to relocate the public alley to an area immediately adjacent to the existing alley, and perpendicular and south of Alter Road. Attached to this Petition is a drawing of the Property indicating the location of the existing alley and the proposed relocation. A copy of this Petition and an ALTA/ACSM Land Title Survey has been sent to the City Engineering Survey Bureau, attention James Foster, at the Bureau's request.

The vacation and relocation of the alley is needed in order to facilitate the expansion of the School and specifically to improve traffic circulation and parking, through the addition of new parking spaces and the strategic relocation of the alley. The relocated alley would be open to traffic and no buildings or structures would obstruct the right-of-way.
