Dear Council President Mahaffey:

Previously, on October 9, 2003, we requested the closing of Raynor Street in the City of Detroit. Please see attached. The security committee for the Frank Murphy Hall of Justice has recommended that Macomb and Clinton Streets also be closed between Beaubien and St. Antoine with access limited only to law enforcement and emergency vehicles. Again, with the aftermath of September 11, the Oklahoma City bombing, as well as bomb threats directed at Frank Murphy Hall of Justice, there are increased security considerations regarding public vehicle access close to the jails and courthouse.
