For several years, my wife and I have owned the 4731 Gallery on Grand River. Recently, we purchased another parcel nearby on the corner of Warren and Grand River. What was the old Michigan Awning Company will soon house an arts group, a theater company and a new gallery. Because we will very soon have several galleries and over 40 artists in the area, we are unofficially beginning to call this area the "Woodbridge West Cultural Association" area.
