Re: Vacation of Plum Street and Second Avenue, between Third Avenue and Grand River Avenue

Gentlemen:

We act as attorneys for MGM Grand Detroit, LLC ("MGM"), the designated developer of a hotel/casino complex (the "Casino") on a site bounded by Third Avenue, Bagley, the Lodge Freeway service drive and the Fisher Freeway service drive (the "Site"), pursuant to the Revised Development Agreement, dated as of August 2, 2002, among MGM, the City of Detroit (fine "City") and the Economic Development Corporation of the City of Detroit.

We understand that The Detroit Edison Company ("DTE") is seeking the City's approval of improvements to its corporate campus which lies immediately across Third Avenue from the Site. Those improvements require, among other things, the vacation of those parts of Plum Street and Second Avenue presently located between Third Avenue and Grand River Avenue so that they may be enclosed within DTE's security perimeter.

When the vacation of Plum and Second came to MGM's attention, it expressed concern that without the direct connection to Grand River, via Plum and Second, MGM might not be able to provide an adequate level of service for vehicular ingress to and egress from the Casino's patron parking deck. Subsequent traffic engineering studies and discussions with DTE, however, have led to an agreement with DTE that will enable MGM's patrons to have access to Grand River via a private easement during MGM's peak operating hours.

Accordingly, MGM hereby withdraws any objection to the vacation of Plum Street and Second Avenue between Third Avenue and Grand River Avenue.

Dear Councilman Cockrel, Ja.:

The tragic events of September 11th have caused DTE Energy to implement additional security measures to insure the safety and security of our employees and prevent the disruption of electrical service to the citizens of Detroit and all of Southeastern Michigan.

The Company sought and obtained the cooperation of the City of Detroit Police Department to temporarily close Second Avenue from Beech Street to Plum Street and Elizabeth Street from Third to Grand River. We are seeking to make the closures permanent. Experience since September 11 demonstrate that the closures do not significantly impact traffic flow.

These closures are essential to protect Company equipment essential to serving the citizens of Detroit and all of Southeastern Michigan. Please note that DTE currently owns the property on both sides of the street in the proposed areas. We are asking that the City Council approve our request to permanently close the aforementioned streets. As a follow up to these street closures we are also requesting that Second Avenue between Plum and Grand River become a two-way street.

We urge your expeditious action concerning this critical security request. A map of the area is attached.
