



RE: Petition No. 99 – Hubbell, Roth and Clark Inc. (HRC for Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan) request for dedications of easement for portion of public walk in the area of Congress Avenue, I – 375 Service Drive, Beaubien Avenue, and St. Antoine Avenue.

Petition No. 99 of "Hubbell, Roth and Clark Inc. (HRC for Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan), request for the Honorable City Council accept easements over Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan land for the construction of sidewalks on I-375 Service Drive between Fort Street, 50 feet wide (vacated) and Congress Avenue, 60 feet wide; also on Congress Avenue, 60 feet wide between on I-375 Service Drive and St. Antoine Avenue, 50 feet wide. The granting of the easement is necessary in order to facilitate the construction of the parking deck/structure and roadway improvements.

The Traffic Engineering Division – DPW, approved and recommend that the petitioner/Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan grant the city of Detroit easements for sidewalk purpose. The petition was referred to the City Engineering Division – DPW for investigation and report. This is our report.



PROVIDED, this resolution is revocable at the will, whim or caprice of the City Council, and "Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan" acquires no implied or other privileges hereunder not expressly stated herein; and further

PROVIDED, That the City Clerk shall within 30 days record a certified copy of this resolution and indemnity agreement with the Wayne County Register of Deeds
