The Elevator RDR, LLC., 2154 Pine Hollow Trail, Brighton, MI proposes to re-develop the Elevator Building at 1938 Franklin Street into Condominiums. The new condos will be immediately adjacent to the proposed Tri-Centennial State Park. Currently there is a public alley which runs between the proposed State Park and the Elevator Building. 
