

Dear Honorable City Council Members,

I am writing on behalf of my family's business, Brown's Bun Baking Company, which is now entering it's 5th generation and 75 years of operation at 4817 W. Vernor Hwy. in Detroit. We have recently made the decision to expand and need your approval to vacate the alley (east-west) and a small portion of the north-south alley directly behind our business.

Our company would provide the public access to the north-south alley between Ferdinand St. and Morrell St. by giving the city an easement from Ferdinand St. by building a new approach (east-west) to access the alley north-south.

The vacation of the east-west alley directly behind our business would only be a request for an easement from the city and there would be <u>no</u> building construction on any part of the current city alleyways. Any new construction would be done on our current West Vernor property up to Morrell St., however, we will construct the necessary and appropriate opaque screening walls to the residential properties to the south and along the edges of our properties on Ferdinand and Morrell Streets. These improvements will create a more safe and secure environment for our operation as well as the surrounding community as a whole. Our bakery property site owns the entire block between Ferdinand and Morrell Streets, with the exception of one business at the corner of West Vernor and Ferdinand. I have had preliminary meetings with the City of Detroit Engineering's, Mr. Noel Perry and Planning and Development's, Khalil Mogassabi regarding our need for an expansion and the maneuverability of the operation as regards this "alleyway" request. They are supportive of the needs and look forward to receiving this official request through the City Clerk's office to investigate further and proceed forward in a timely fashion. P&DD and our local business association known as the Southwest Detroit Business Association, will also work together with our architectural firm to insure that our improvements,

along with our existing buildings on Vernor meet the "Traditional Main Street Overlay Design Standards."


