

To whom it may concern:

Groundwater & Environmental Services, Inc. (GES), on behalf of ExxonMobil Oil Corporation (ExxonMobil), is requesting a petition number for the Right-of-Way (ROW) permit intended for Ashton Ave and southern alley adjacent to the above referenced address. GES would like to install one (1) monitoring well in the eastern ROW of Ashton Ave, one (1) monitoring wells in the alley south of address listed above, per the attached site plan. GES will not need to close any portion of the affected roadways in order to complete the proposed ROW work. Therefore, please find enclosed a Certificate of Insurance, meeting all city requirements, a site map with proposed monitoring well locations, and a monitoring well detail diagram. GES proposes to commence work effective August 1, 2008. This work is being performed as part of an on-going environmental investigation, therefore the monitoring wells will need to remain in place for approximately 5 - 10 years. Upon completion of the monitoring wells, groundwater samples will be collected for analysis on a biannual basis. All monitoring wells will be properly abandoned when they are no longer required.

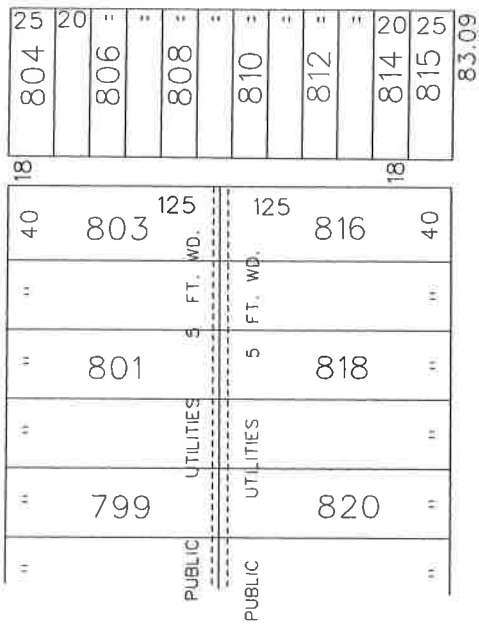

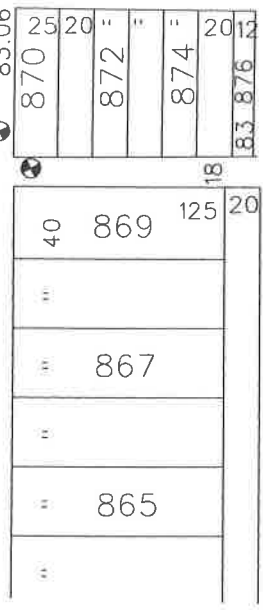


120 FT. WD. SEVEN MILE

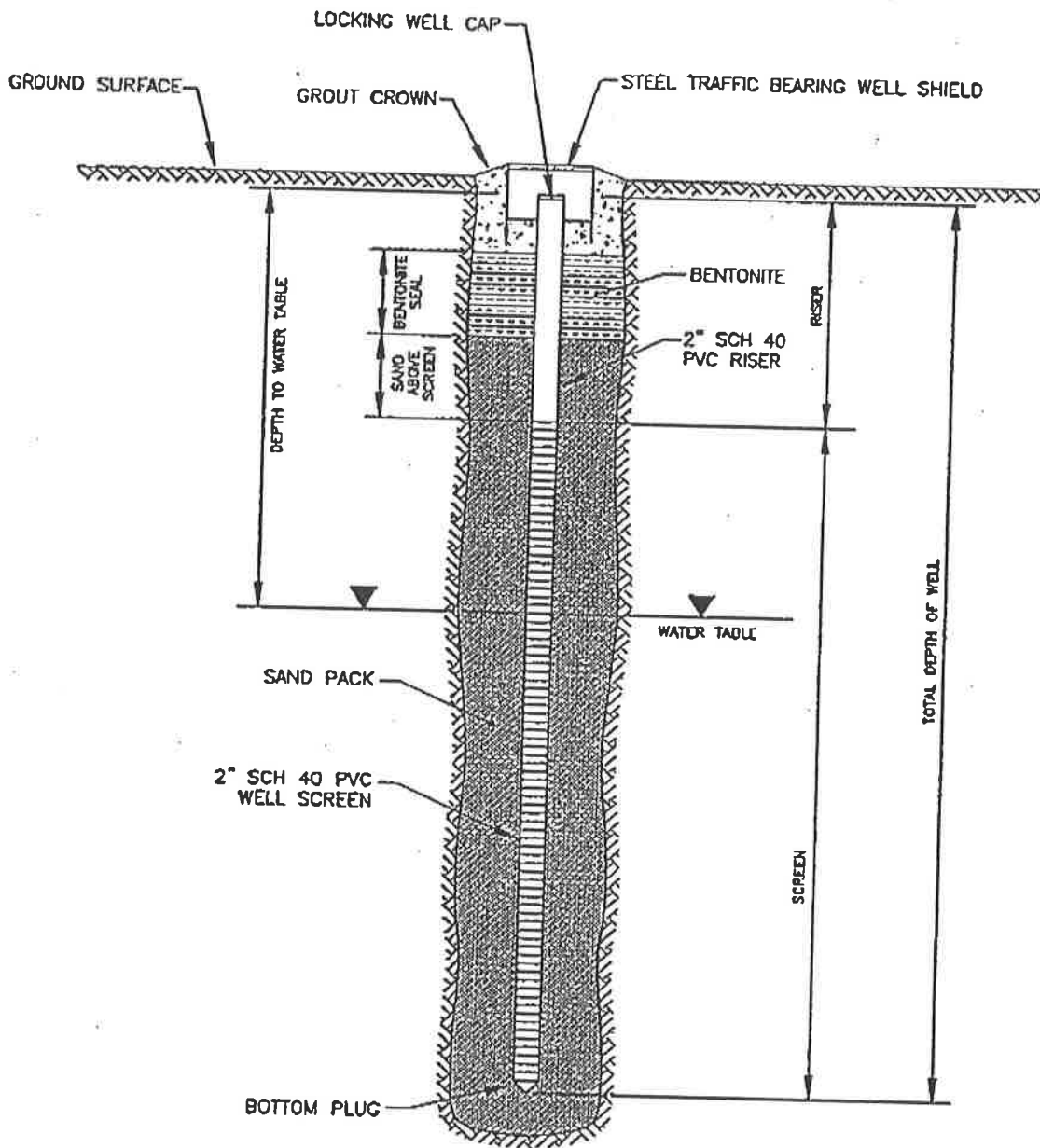
