This letter is a request to allow Mt. Olive Lutheran Church, 4444 Radnor, Detroit, to improve the berm between Radnor Street and the sidewalk adjacent to the church, located outside the church. In particular, the church is petitioning the city council in order to allow the church to seek professional assistance to place a gutter and curb and pave the right-of-way on Radnor Street, just north of Mack Avenue, adjacent to the church. In addition to the placement of curb, we are requesting that parking be permitted within the current berm area, as the berm would be removed when the curb and asphalt pavement are installed.

At the present time, there is no curb or gutter in the area, causing a continuous muddy situation between the sidewalk and the street. Our parishioners are currently parking cars adjacent to the church and must sometimes walk through mud in order to get to the sidewalk. The placement of a curb and improvement of the berm would substantially upgrade that area. The church has been operating without a curb for several decades. The church was built in late 1950s.
