- (x) Involved; **have objection** to the requested vacation of the 20 foot wide E/W alleys (and Gerisch St) in the area bound by Fort St, Dearborn Ave., Barron and the Chesapeake & Ohio R.W as shown in drawing x2778.dgn dated 7/8/2013. Due to the lack of required information on the drawing, Traffic Engineering Division could not assess if Gerisch Street would be dead-ended at the railroad if it was vacated as shown on X2778. While drawing x2778 shows Barron Avenue as an open street, our field investigation showed it to be illegally closed and fenced in. In order to avoid any potential dead-ending of the streets at the railroad tracks, Survey Bureau is requested to provide Traffic Engineering Division with a drawing which shows the current status of the streets bound by Fort, Dearborn, I-75, and Forman Street for proper review.
