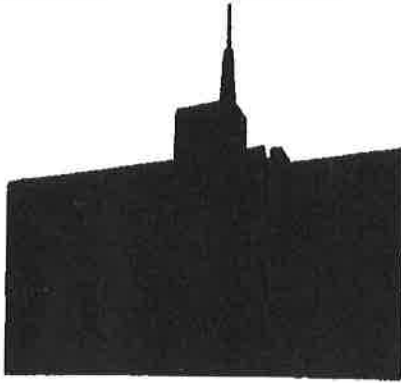

It has come to our attention that the parking lot alley located in the back of the Bethany Baptist Church located at 15122 W. Chicago, Detroit, MI, 48228 between Coyle and Sussex, is in possible violation of the City of Detroit Municipal Code. We do apologize for this inconvenience, however, we would like for this alley to be closed off permanently. The alley is part of the parking lot for the church. We have reviewed our paperwork to discover that the first temporary closing was filed in the Journal of Common Council on pg. 1846. It was first closed July 26, 1985 (the petition reference #3458).

We request that a petition to permanently close off the alley be filed seeing as the gated entry grounds are to egress and ingress.
