Honorable Members of the Council,

We, the congregation of Resurrection Lutheran Church, located at 20531 Kelly Road, Detroit, hereby re-petition the Council to temporarily close the alley running behind our church property, between Carlisle and Collingham Drive, originally closed in 1964. (Petition #7112)

Resurrection Lutheran Church request is that the temporary closing of the alley be continued for another five (5) years. The reasons for making the request are the same as those which were stated in the original petition in 1964.

1. The closing of the alley prevents its use as a short cut by people which caused traffic hazards in the past.
2. The alley is not used for the pick-up of garbage and trash.
3. The closing of the alley has protected the property from vandals and its use at night for illegal dumping, parking, and drinking parties.

For these reasons we respectfully request that our petition be granted.
