

Any fence and gate installation must provide 13 feet horizontal and 15 feet vertical clearance(s) for utility maintanance vehicles. "All other City departments and privately owned utility companies have reported no objections to the closing, provided they have the right to ingress and egress at all times to their facilities. Further, the petitioner shall comply with all specific conditions imposed to feature unimpeded 24-hour-per-day access to the City and utility companies; and Provided, All of the petitioner's public property fence and gate installation(s) shall be subject to the review and approval of the City Engineering Department (if necessary, in conjunction with the Department of Public Works—Traffic Engineering Division, Planning Department, and the Community and Economic Development Department); and

Provided, The patitioner's fence and
gate installation shall provide 13 feet horizontal and 15 feet vartical disessance(s)
for utility maintenance vehicles; and
Provided, This resolution does not permit the storage of materials, display of
merchandles, or signs within the temporarity closed public street. Further, the
placement of materials, merchandles, or

placement of materials, merchandise, or signs on any adjacent berm area is prohibited; and Provided, That at the expiration of the permit, all obstructions shall be removed at the petitioner's expense. The public properly shall be restored to a condition satisfactory to the City Engineering Department by the petitioner at the petitioner's expense; and Provided, This resolution is revocable at the will, whim or caprice of the City Council without cause. The petitioner values the right to claim damages or compensation for removal of encotachments. Further, the permittee acquires no implied or other privileges hereunder not expressly stated herein. If this permit is continued for the five (6) year period, the City Council may (upon written request and if the circumstances justify accordingly) grant an extension thereto; and

Provided, This permit shall not be assigned or transferred without the writ-ten approval of the City Council; and fur-
