The HDC Commission finds the work appropriate for the following reasons:

The applicant proposes to construct bike racks in the 16 Local Historic Districts and at the locations referenced above in this letter. The work will be done according to the attached plans and specifications, but there is one change in the scope of work and specifications for 4626 Third Street.
