I'm writing to you in hopes that you might be able to assist me with a situation I have at my store regarding parking. Although there is parking available along the street to the side of the store, it is becoming very dangerous to park there as cars are being vandalized and broken into on a very regular basis.

I'm very concerned about my wife, myself and my three employees safety while parking in this area. It's very easy for vandals to target this area because although there is a street light positioned on that street, it is non-operational and therefore doesn't serve it's purpose. I have been told there may be no functioning street light there for as long as 1 ½ years.
