Gardenview Estates- Request for Temporary Street Closure

Dear Mr. Doherty:

The Detroit Housing Commission ("DHC") requests the City of Detroit's ("City") approval to install a chain link fence around the undeveloped portion of the Gardenview Estates site, which will temporarily enclose the public streets. The installation of the fence is a requirement by the Department of Environmental Quality ("DEQ") to receive full approval of our Documentation of Due Care Compliance ("DDCC"). The DEQ provided conditional approval of the DDCC with the requirement that the site had to be seeded and fenced. The seeding, which has been completed, provides a vegetative cover on the site which is critical because the lots have not been remediated. The fence will be the main exposure barrier because it will deter pedestrians from walking onto the site and having contact with the contaminated soils.

There will be some access to the site as construction on rental phase IV has commenced. Also, the public lighting installation is in progress and will be completed by August 22, 2014. Enclosed is one (1) set of pavement repair plans and one (1) set of perimeter fencing plans. A copy of this letter with a set of plans has been submitted to the City Clerk's office.




