Why:

To provide an alternative method of donating money to the homeless population without giving money directly to a panhandler. In other cities this has provided a shift in how people interact with the homeless. The less money someone gives to a panhandler the less likely a panhandler is to wander downtown. Additionally, the more money we collect to address the root causes of homelessness (rather than just the symptoms) the more we can get people back on their feet and reduce the number of homeless in the City of Detroit.

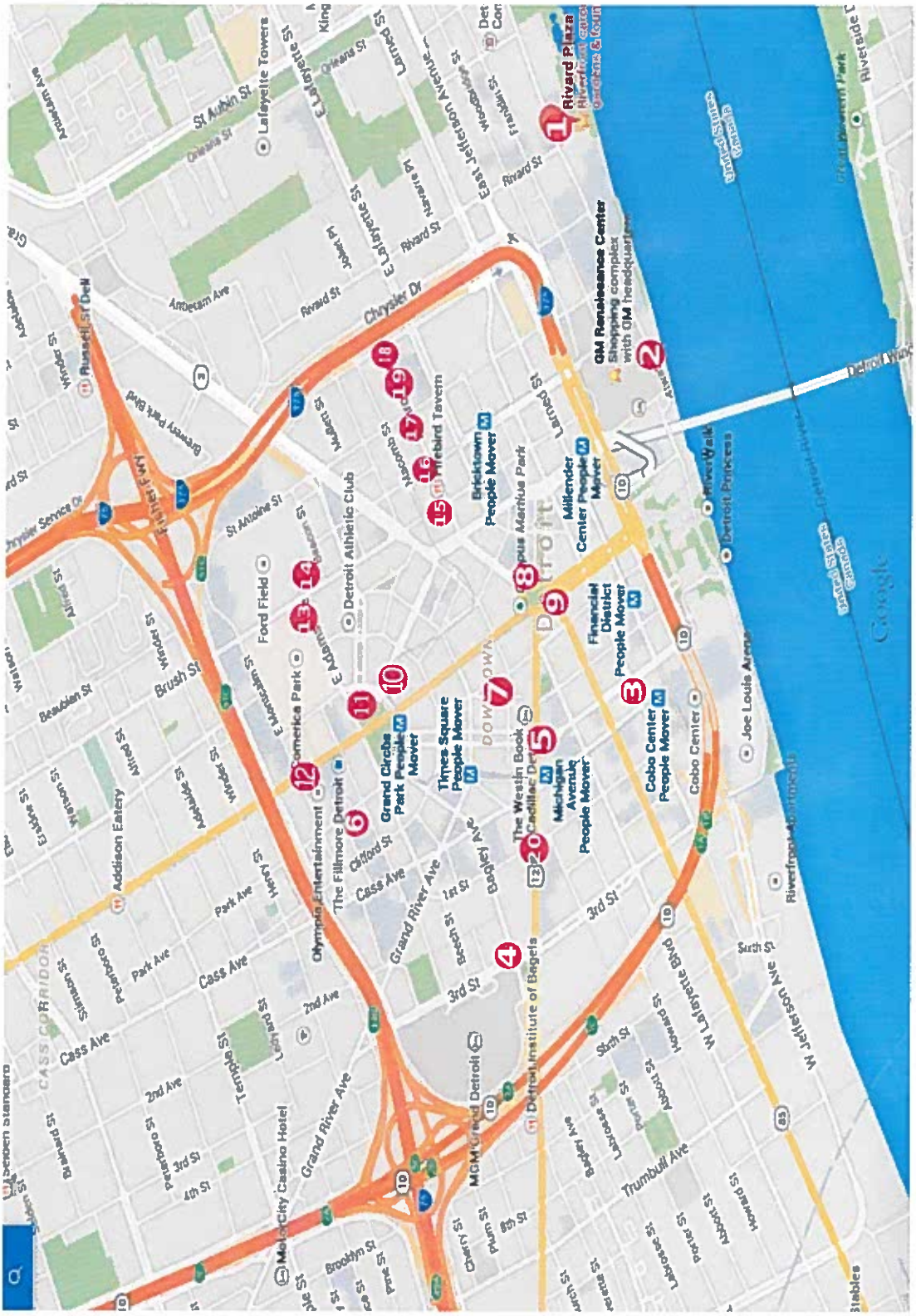

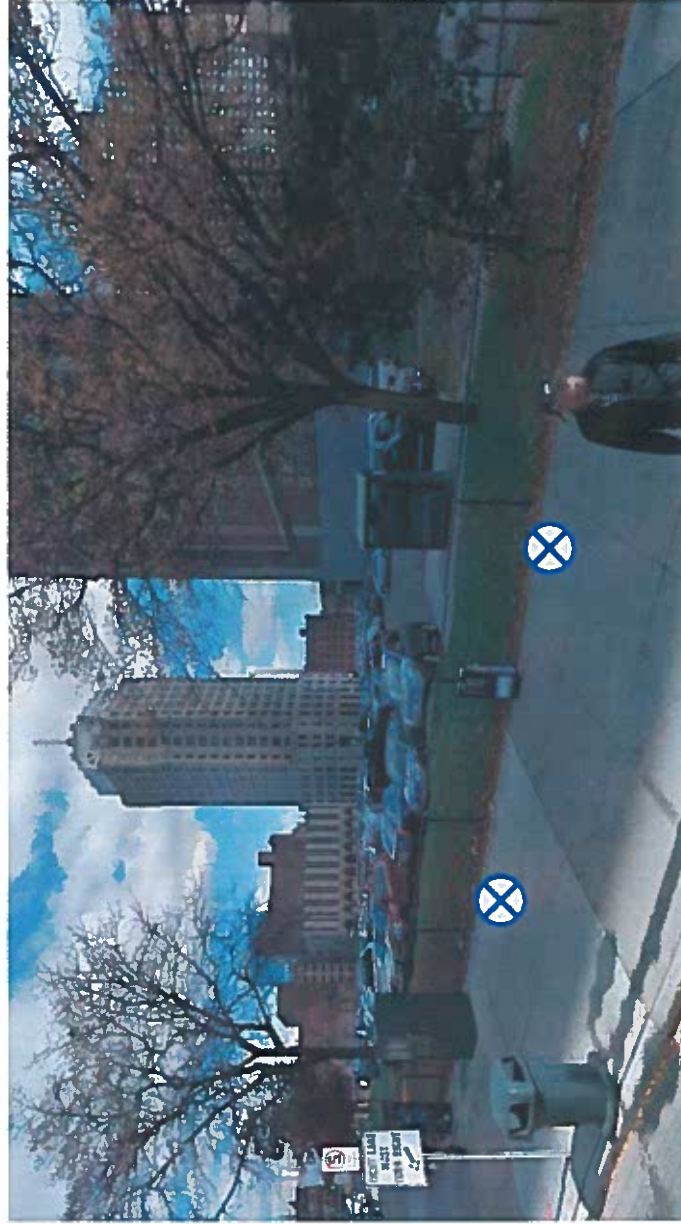

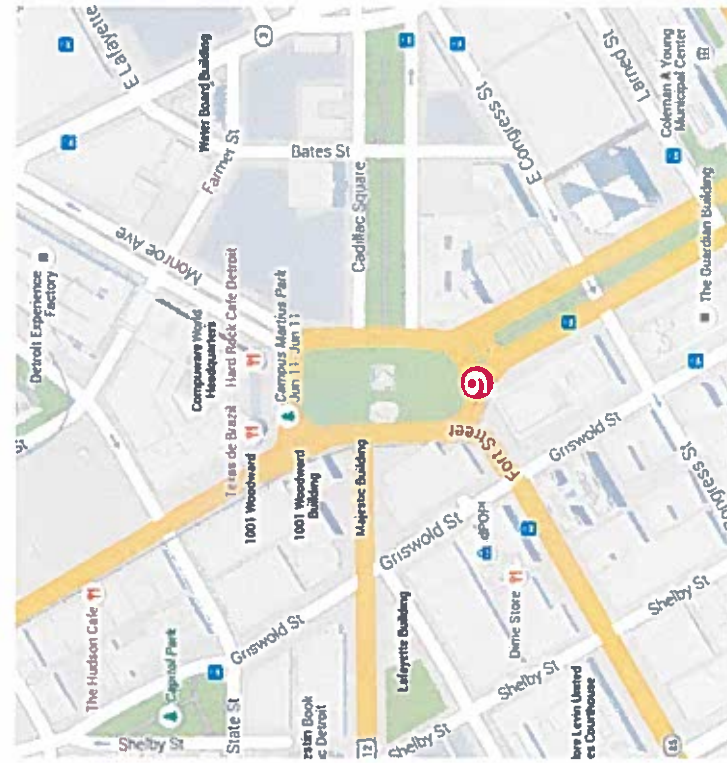

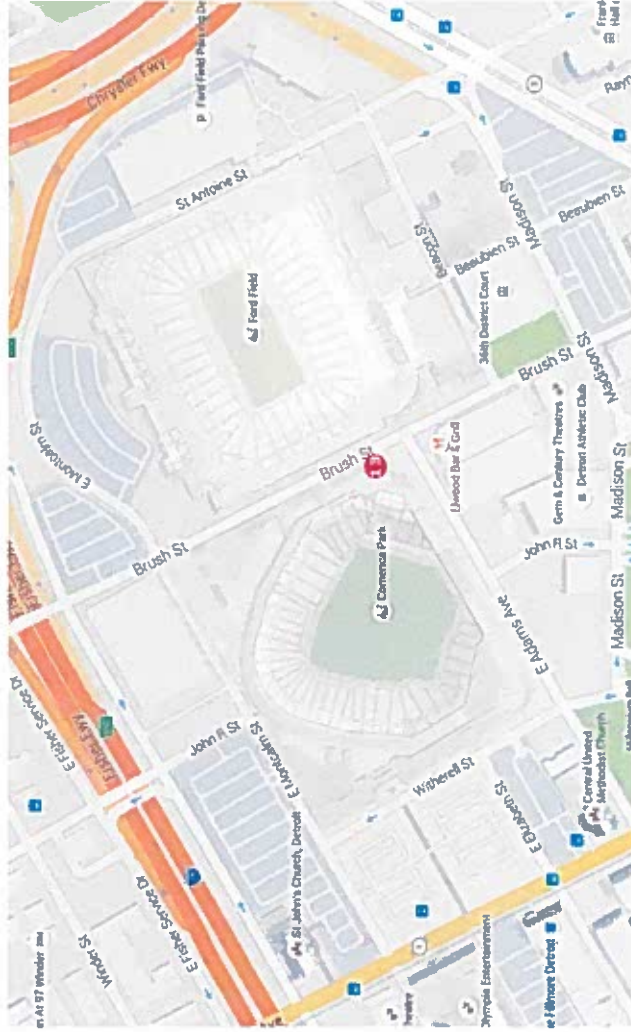

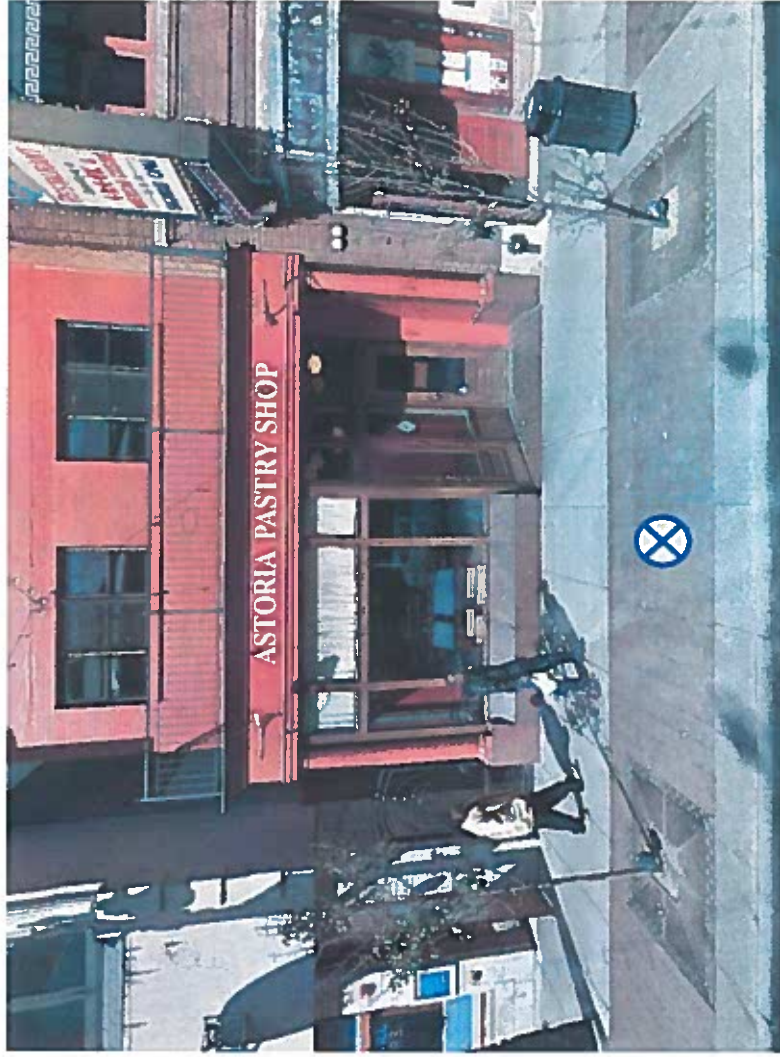
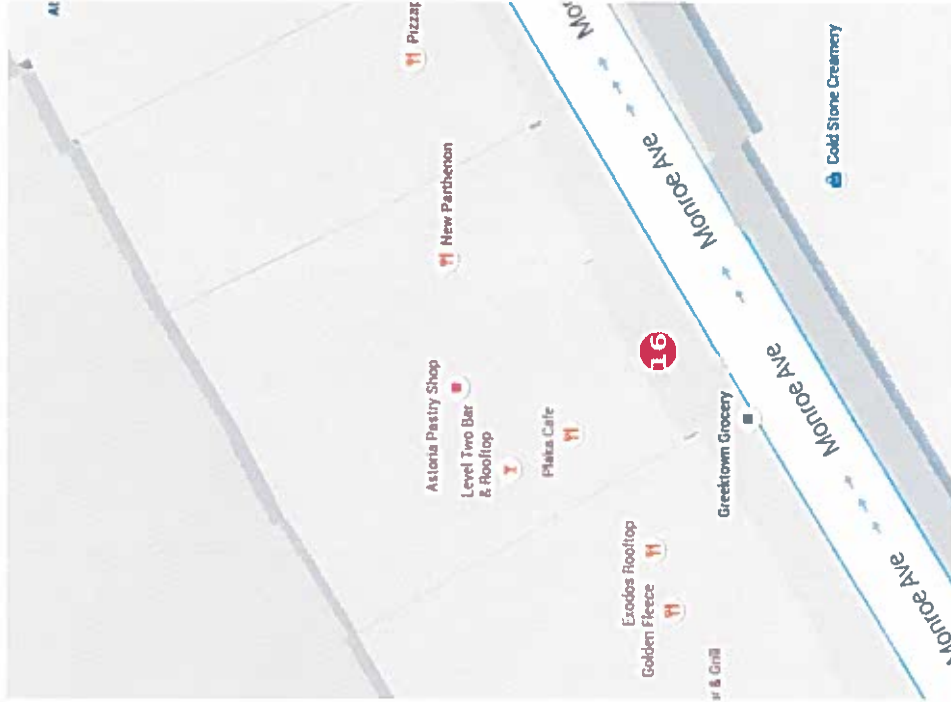
Please note: We intentionally picked a location that is far enough away from the game day entrance lines that it will not interfere.

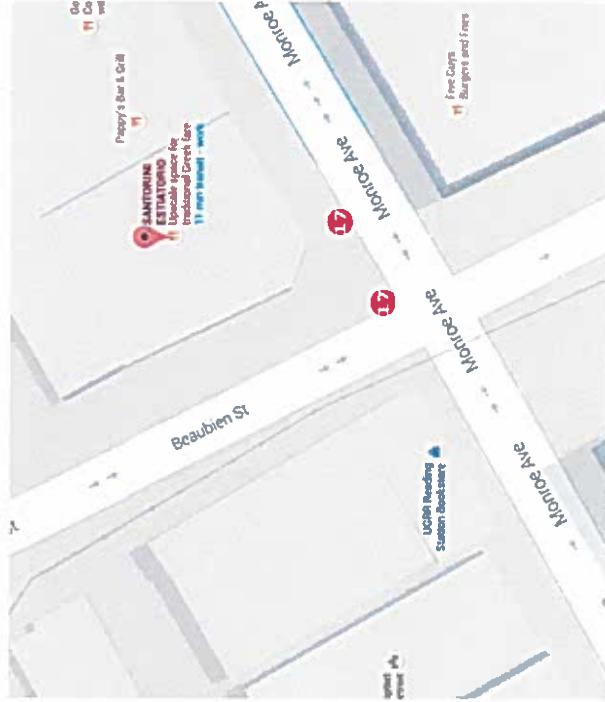

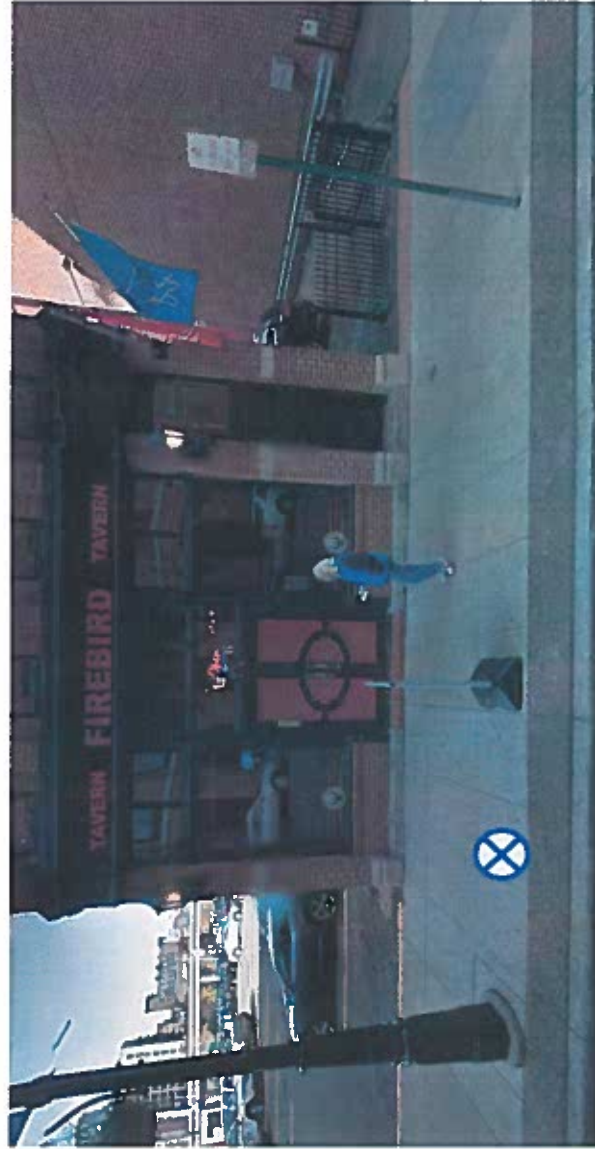
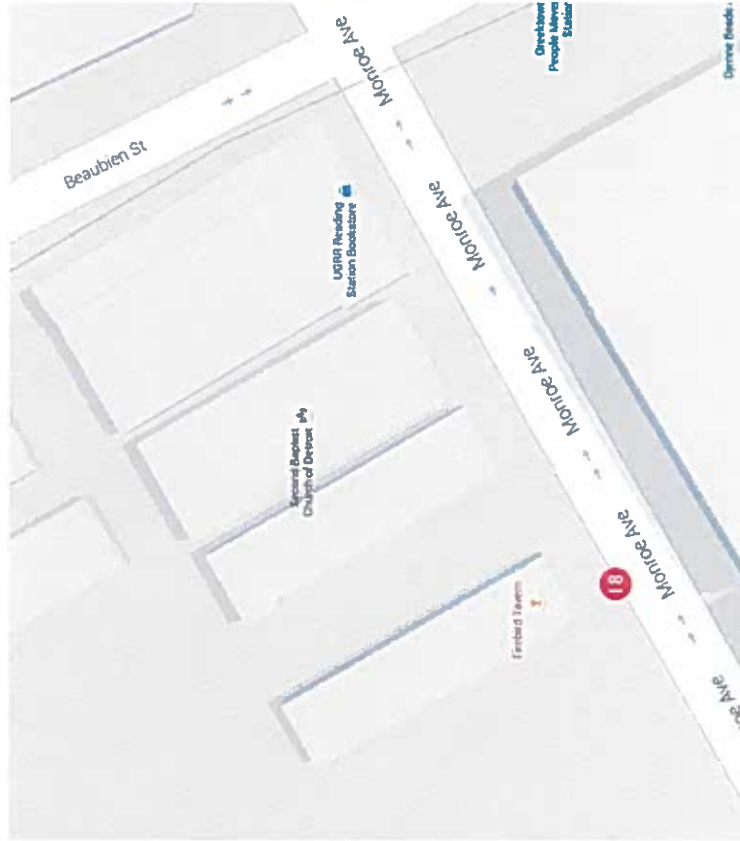
Please Note: the meter should be installed 4 feet from the curb, in line with the 2 trees

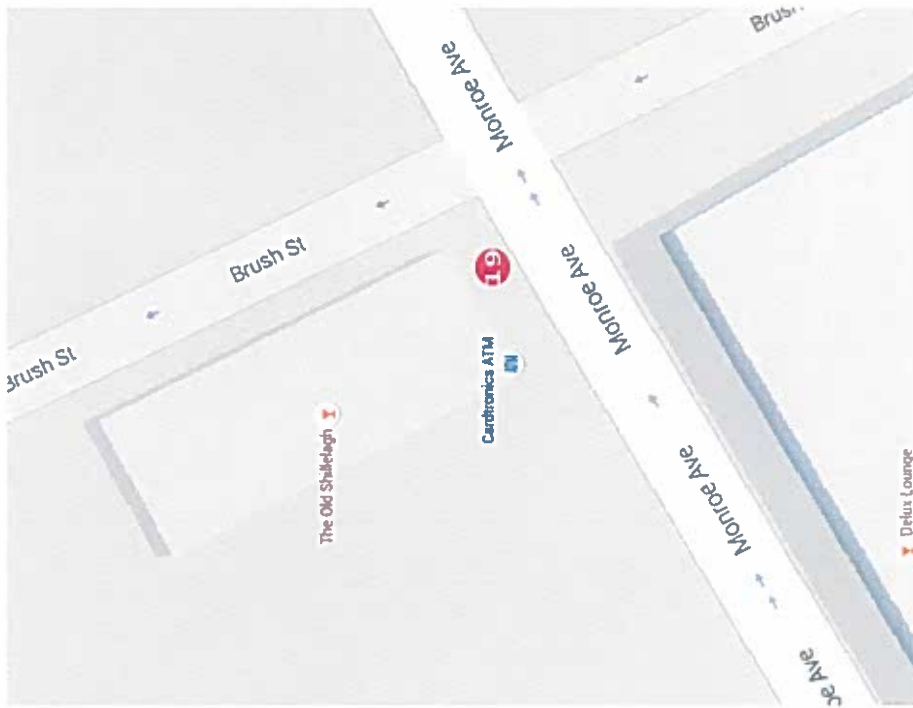


Please note: We are comfortable with either of the marked locations. Also, please note that the trees are being removed as part of a right of way redesign. We propose putting the meter where the tree was.
