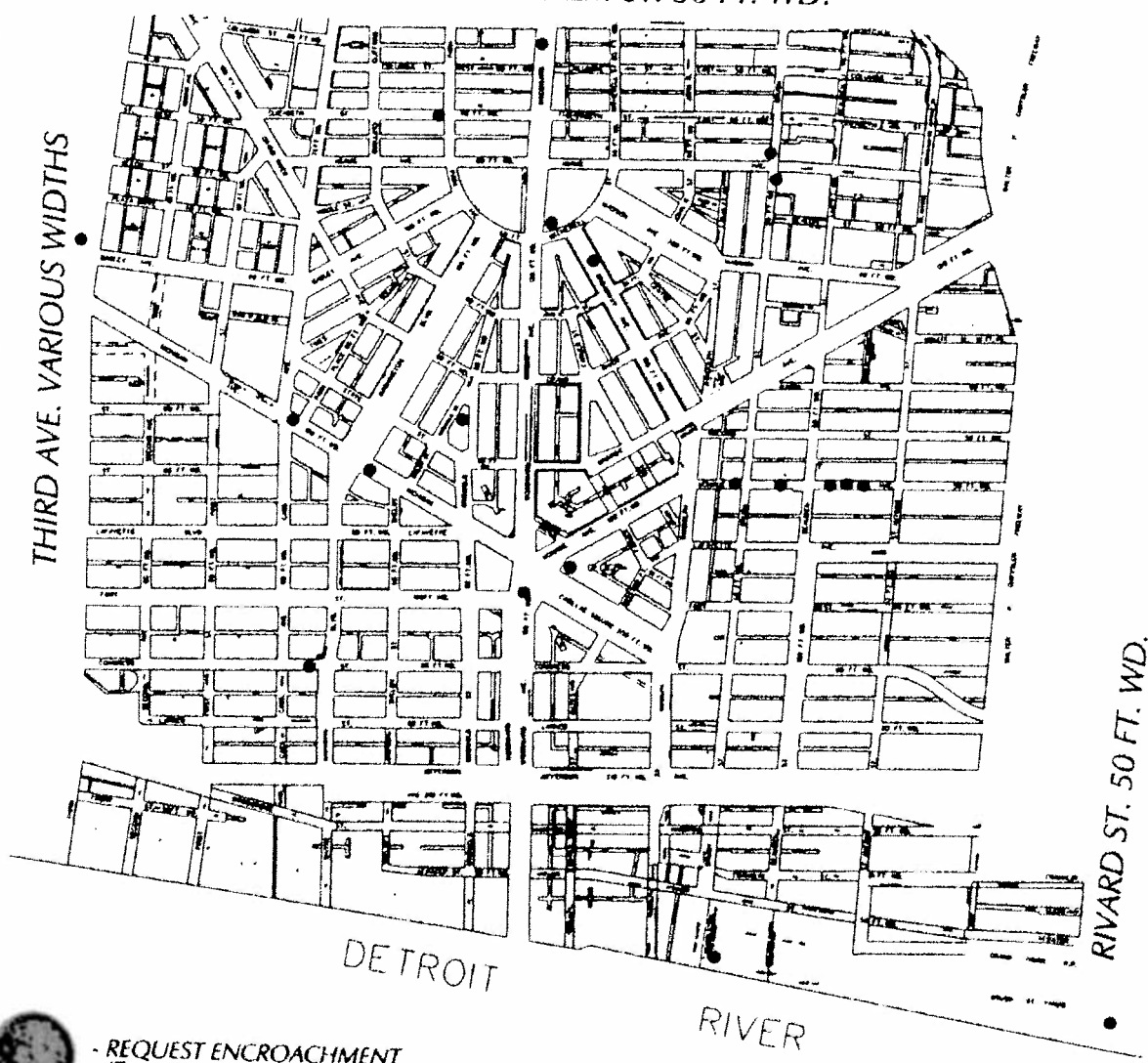

Detroit Donates – A program that allows for the repurposing of parking meters in both public and private spaces downtown. Parking meters are to be installed in the right-of-way in order to allow for the collection of money. The money that is collected will go toward certified non-profit organizations that service homeless individuals.

When:
From July 2015 –Until. These will be permanent encroachments

Where:

Why:
To provide an alternative method of donating money to the homeless population without giving money directly to a panhandler. In other cities this has provided a shift in how people interact with the homeless. The less money someone gives to a panhandler the less likely a panhandler is to wander downtown. Additionally, the more money we collect to address the root causes of homelessness (rather than just the symptoms) the more we can get people back on their feet and reduce the number of homeless in the City of Detroit.
