RE: Petition 887, permanent closure of Hartwick Street from Clay Avenue to East Euclid Avenue; and East Euclid Avenue from Riopelle Street to Grand Trunk Railroad

City Engineering Division – DPW has processed Petition No. 887 – Euclid Manufacturing, request to vacate and convert to easement East Euclid Avenue, 60 feet wide from Riopelle Street, 46 feet wide to the Grand Trunk Railroad also part of Hartwick Avenue, variable width, Clay Avenue, 66 feet wide to Euclid Avenue, 60 feet wide.

This request being made to facilitate a manufacturing complex with free flowing traffic and pedestrian access between buildings; also to provide security for Euclid Manufacturing.

Our assessor's records list you as a property owner or business occupying property adjoining the proposed street closures. Euclid Manufacturing has sent certified mail with return receipt to the property owners and the received no response.

At this time our office is moving forward with a resolution (attached) for the permanent closure of:

- 1) Hartwick Street from Clay Avenue to East Euclid Avenue
- 2) East Euclid Avenue from Riopelle to Grand Trunk Railroad
