

On Tuesday, March 15, 2016, I received Petition #1002, I was also instructed by Sgt. Marian Champion of the Fourth Precinct to check the neighboring location to get feedback from the citizens and place their information in my response. The petitioner, Nagi Mohammad, stated they would like to propose a vacation of property. The location is the Alley between West Warren Ave. and Holmes Ave, from McDonald Ave heading west ending at the Penna.-Detroit Rail Road tracks.

On Wednesday, March 16, 2016, at approximately 11:30 AM, I canvassed the location and found no residential homes within the area. I then made the location of 8024 Homes Ave and talked to Jerry Douglas, the owner of this location, (313) 655-5391, who stated that, His business would not be affected by this propose change. He also stated that there are a total of 4 businesses off the alley of the propose location and they have all agreed to clean and maintain the proposed area. They have all been advised of the proposed change and none of them have any objection to this petition.

My investigation revealed that there were no objections to this petition by the businesses located in the surrounding area. There are no building on the West Warren Ave. side of the area to be vacated and the propose change will not affect the services provided by the Detroit Police Department. I recommend that petition #1002 be approved as long as access is allowed for emergency services.
