On Thursday, March 17, 2016, I received Petition #1022, I was also instructed by Sgt. Marian Champion of the Fourth Precinct to check the neighboring location to get feedback from the citizens and place their information in my response. The petitioner, Nasser M. Aljalham, stated they would like to propose a vacation of property. The location is the Alley between South Dix Ave. and Fordson Ave, from Ormond Ave heading north ending at Powell Ave.

On Friday, March 18, 2016, at approximately 10:00 AM, I canvassed the location and found no residential homes within the area. I then made the locations of the following businesses in the area:

- 403 S. Dix Ave, Power Strip Bar/Club. I did not get an answer at the door
  of this location, but I did observe the alley behind this location has been
  closed and the parking lot has been extended into the alley.
- 371 S. Dix Ave, Dix Wrenchwork Truck Repair. I talked to Alex Oswald (313-843-4199), the owner of this location who stated they have been at this location for over fourteen years and the alley has been closed for approximately ten years.
- 303 S. Dix Ave, M.I.K. Used Auto Sales. I talked to Ibrahim Aljamash (313-445-5671), the owner of this location who stated his business has been at this location for over six years and the alley was closed when they moved there.
- 374 S. Fordson Ave, Vulcanmasters Welding Company, Inc. I talked to Roger Pappas (313-843-5043), the president of the company who stated their company has been at this location for twenty nine years. He also stated he attended a Zoning Board meeting where it was approved that the alley would be closed and all the property owners would be allowed to extend their property to the center of the alley. This took place over ten years ago.
- 420 Fordson Ave, Misan Enterprise Inc. Auto Wholesale, I talked to Hatim Muhsen-Yasser Al-Musawy (313-842-2723), the manager of this location who stated the property was extended to the alley when he started working there.

They have all been advised of the proposed change and none of them have any objection to this petition.
