Attached is a (very rough) map showing the alley vacation we discussed yesterday. If we could get the eastern 102 feet of the alley totally vacated and the balance of the alley remaining subject to the DTE easement, I think this would work for both of us, as it keeps the totally vacated part about 10 feet away from your easternmost power pole. I measured the distance myself and then confirmed it with our surveyor.
