On Thursday, June 16, 2016, I received Petition #1165, I was also instructed by Sergeant Marian Champion of the Fourth Precinct to check the neighboring locations to see if this closure would interfere with the normal access to their property. The petitioner, Mike Fisher, stated he would like to propose a vacation of property. The location of this property is the east / west alley between Annabelle Ave, and Beatrice, north of Schaefer Hwy and south of Toronto Ave.

On Thursday, June 16, 2016, at approximately 5:00 PM, I canvassed the location and found no sign of recent use of this alley. I also observed the alley to be unmaintained and the vegetation overgrown. I made the location of 1641 Annabelle and there was no answer at the door. It is unknown at this time if the location is occupied.

My investigation revealed that the closure of this alley will not hinder the city services that are provided to the citizens of this community. The properties next to the proposed change will not have any obstructions to their normal form of access and the propose change will not affect the services provided by the Detroit Police Department. I recommend that petition #1165 be approved as long as access is allowed for emergency services.
