On Monday, September 22, 2016, I received the revised Petition for #X1190, the petitioner is requesting to convert to easement the north/south public alley, 20 ft. wide, in the block bound by Morton, Gilbert, Morse St. and Livernois.

On Tuesday, September 13, 2016, I canvassed the location and I spoke with the petitioner Blanca Rosales-Lopez of 6327 Morse St. Ms. Rosales-Lopez directed me to the alley in which she is requesting to close. I observed that Ms. Rosales-Lopez is requesting to close the north/south public alley not the east/west alley as indicated in original the petition. This petition was revised to reflect the correct alley to be closed. On September 30, 2016, I spoke with Michael Andrews, W/M/38 of 6337 Morse, who stated he has no objection to the property change. This property change would not affect police services or emergency services to the residents or businesses in the area. Therefore, I recommend petition X1190 is approved.

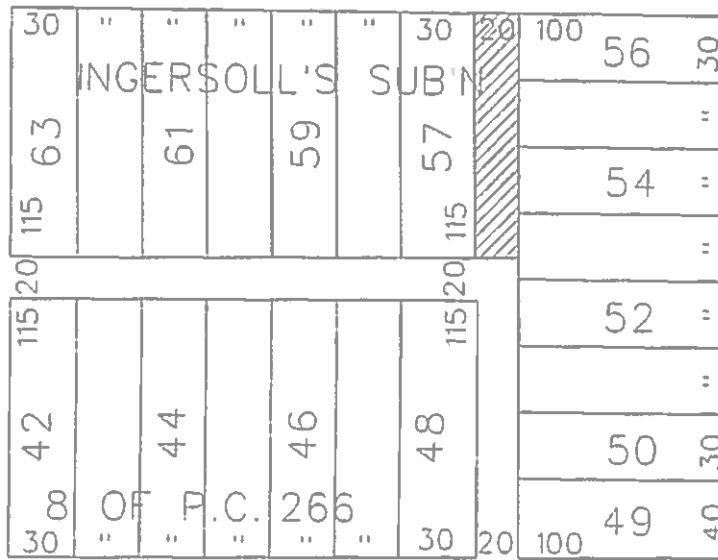
