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



In reviewing the proposed Livernois encroachment, I have determined the proposal not be approved due to several facts outlined below. Originally, Livernois was a six lane highway. However, after a study of the high number of vehicle accidents in the area was completed several years ago, there was a median constructed from Eight Mile to I-96 Freeway which cut the lanes down from three each way to two each way. This action did slow traffic and reduced the number of vehicle accidents.

The temporary encroachment that exists now from Eight Mile to Seven Mile has cut traffic down to one single lane which is causing a bottle neck at the slightest increase of traffic. Also it is causing more traffic through the residential streets in the surrounding neighborhood. Furthermore, there is a problem when emergency vehicles come through the area and have to face the same bottle neck because of the single lane. There is also a bike lane and a multitude of traffic and advertising signs in the area that tends to constantly distract drivers. Lastly, the parking lane creates a problem for traffic again due to the fact that each time a vehicle stops to park, a traffic back up is created. Therefore, I have determined the proposal not be approved.
