This is in response to your email dated August 24, 2016 and received by our office on the same.

A review of the above petition with our department records indicates that GLWA has the following:

√ 24-inch water main within Livernois Avenue

A condition of granting permission to encroach into GLWA's 24-inch water main easement, GLWA will still have the right to fix or replace our 24-inch water main within the easement. The property owner will be responsible for replacement of property within the easement.

Please provide GLWA with completed construction plans showing our 24-inch water main located within the area of the proposed art structures (both locations) profiles and located from the property line as to where the footings will be located before work is to start within your proposed area for further review.

The customer must perform exploratory for elevation or verification of location, GLWA requires inspection for this work. See DWSD GBS N-567. Please contact GLWA 10 days before and 3 days in advance of construction.

A minimum net vertical clearance of 18-inches between the top of the GLWA (or bottom of the GLWA utility) and any other structures must be maintained.

Please be advised that GLWA recommend a minimum net horizontal clearance of 10-feet between utilities or structure.

In cases where it is not practical to maintain an agreed separation, the reviewing authority may allow deviation on a case-by-case basis, if supported by data from the design engineer.
