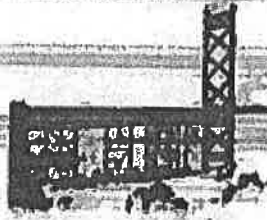

In accordance with Detroit Code 50 article 3, the Detroit International Bridge Company (DIBC) is formally requesting an outright vacation with easements of St. Anne Street between Fort Street and Lafayette Ave. DIBC owns all property on both sides of St. Anne between Fort Street and Lafayette. Additionally, this portion of St. Anne Street has been closed as part of the Gateway Project for over three years along with 18th Street & 15th Street between Fort Street & Lafayette. 18th Street and 15th Street will be opened again shortly as the Gateway Project is wrapped up.

DIBC is requesting the vacation with easements to allow for connecting property to be connected for parking of both Customs and DIBC employees while maintaining security for both vehicles and personnel of our respective organizations. This will also allow the historic maintenance facility to be connected with the border which will allow faster reaction by bridge maintenance staff to emergency needs.


