On Monday, September 26, 2016, the Fourth Precinct received route slip NPB-38, Petition no. 931, for an investigation. The City Engineering Division, Department of Public Works is requesting a response from the Detroit Police Department regarding a property change.

The petitioner, Detroit Salt Company is requesting to outright vacate a portion of Bayside Ave. and Dumfries Ave., in the blocks bound by Oakwood Blvd., Sanders, Dunkirk Ave. and Wabash R.R. On Monday, February 1, 2016, and Wednesday, February 3, 2016, this petition was originally investigated. The investigation revealed that both streets to be vacated are dead end streets and are one city block. Dumfries Ave. and Bayside Ave. dead ends at the Detroit Salt Company and to the south of the location are vacant fields. The petitioner has requested to revise the original petition to add two additional alleys to be vacated. The vacant lots on Dumfries and Bayside are owned by the petitioner, Detroit Salt Company and there are no residents living in this area to be vacated.

On Thursday, September 29, 2016, I went back to the location to investigate the alleys being requested to outright vacate. The vacation of both streets and alleys would not affect our police services to the nearby residents or businesses in this area. Emergency responding units may either enter on Sanders or Ormond to assist the residents and the businesses in area. Therefore, with the actions taken, I recommend no objection to this property change and this matter be considered closed.
