Ladies and Gentlemen,

Sakthi Automotive Group USA, Inc., Sakthi America Corporation and North American Commerce Center, LLC, hereby submits this amended request to vacate the following streets, alley and related rights of way, with the understanding that the vacation of Waterman and Post Avenue would be subject to reserved easements for existing utilities:

- 1. Waterman from W. Fort to the Wabash Railroad Right of Way;
- 2. The east-west alley located south of the north 10 feet of Lots 14 and 57 of Beard's Subdivision of part of lots 18 and 19 of Wesson's Section of part of P.C. 267;
 - 3. Post Avenue from W. Fort to Wabash Railroad Right of Way.
