

On Wednesday, March 2, 2016, I received Petition x947, I was also instructed by Captain Whitney Walton of the Fourth Precinct to check the neighboring location to get feedback from the citizens and place their information in my response. The petitioner, Sakthi Automotive Group USA, INC, stated they would like to propose a vacation of property on Post Ave. and Waterman Ave. between West Fort St. and the Wabash Rail Road tracks.

On Thursday, March 3, 2016, at approximately 1:30 PM, I canvassed the location and found no residential homes within the area.
