On Wednesday, March 2, 2016, I received Petition x947, I was also instructed by Captain Whitney Walton of the Fourth Precinct to check the neighboring location to get feedback from the citizens and place their information in my response. The petitioner, Sakthi Automotive Group USA, INC, stated they would like to propose a vacation of property on Post Ave. and Waterman Ave. between West Fort St. and the Wabash Rail Road tracks.

On Thursday, March 3, 2016, at approximately 1:30 PM, I canvassed the location and found no residential homes within the area. I then made the location of 100 American Way Street and talked to Ken Milewski (Manager) of MP&L, (313) 558-6513, who stated that, this business located west of the vacation area is owned by the petitioner. He also stated the businesses and property on the east of the vacation area, both between West Fort and the Wabash Rail Road tracks are owned by the petitioner. The management of all the properties has been advised of the proposed change and none of them have any objection to this petition.

My investigation revealed that there were no objections to this petition by the businesses located in the surrounding area. This propose change will not affect the services provided by the Detroit Police Department. I recommend that petition x947 be approved as long as access is allowed for emergency services.
