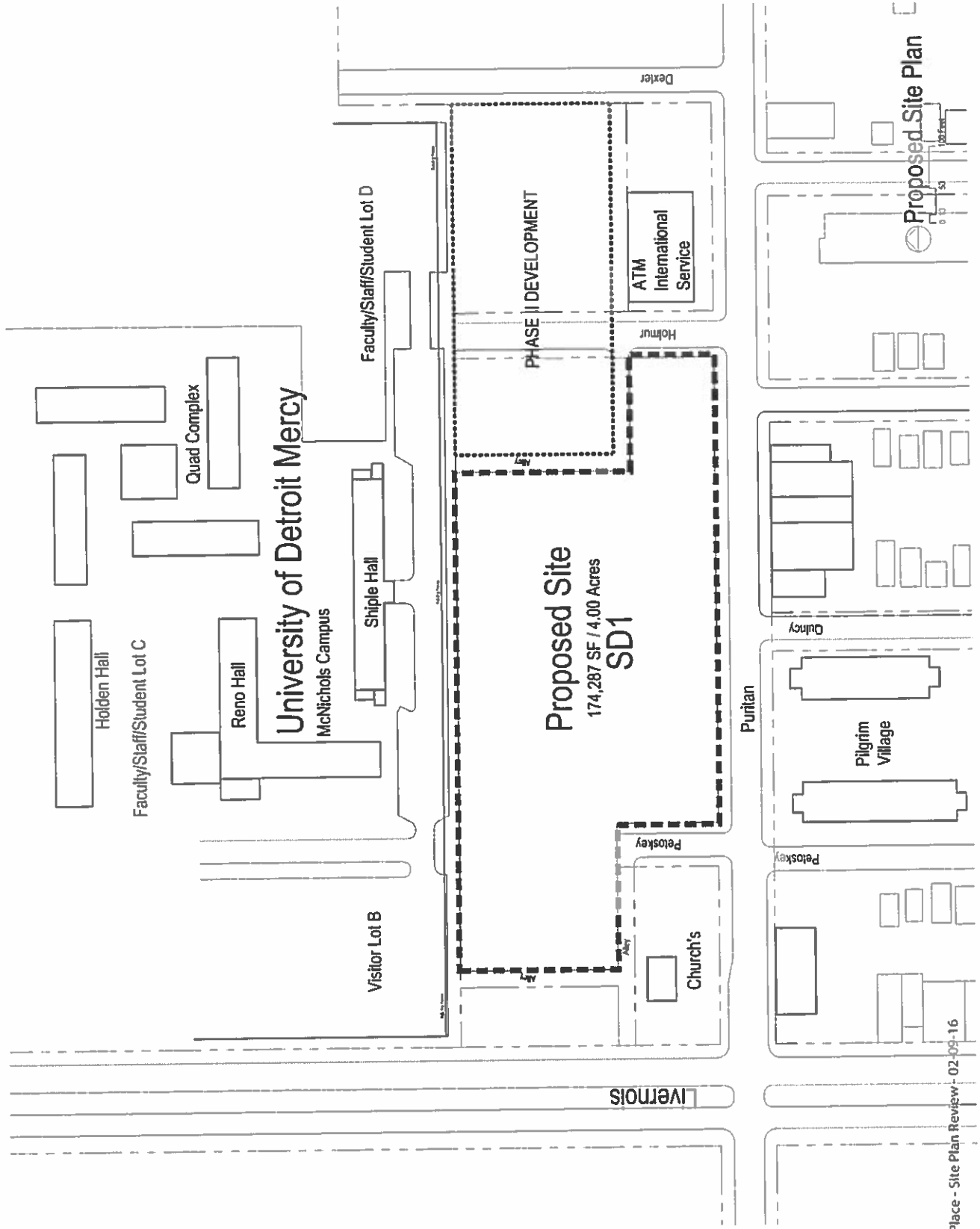


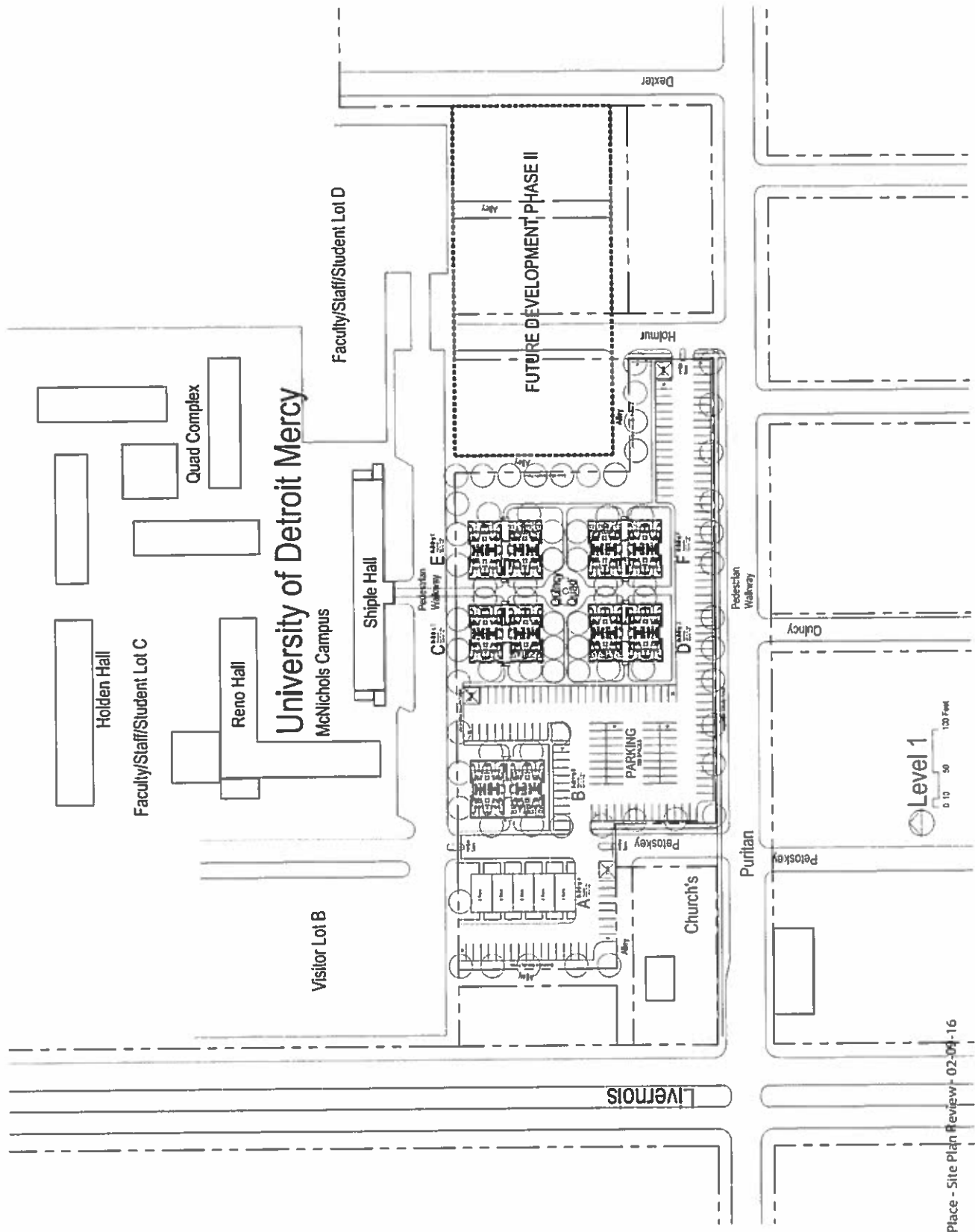
Existing Campus  
Site Plan

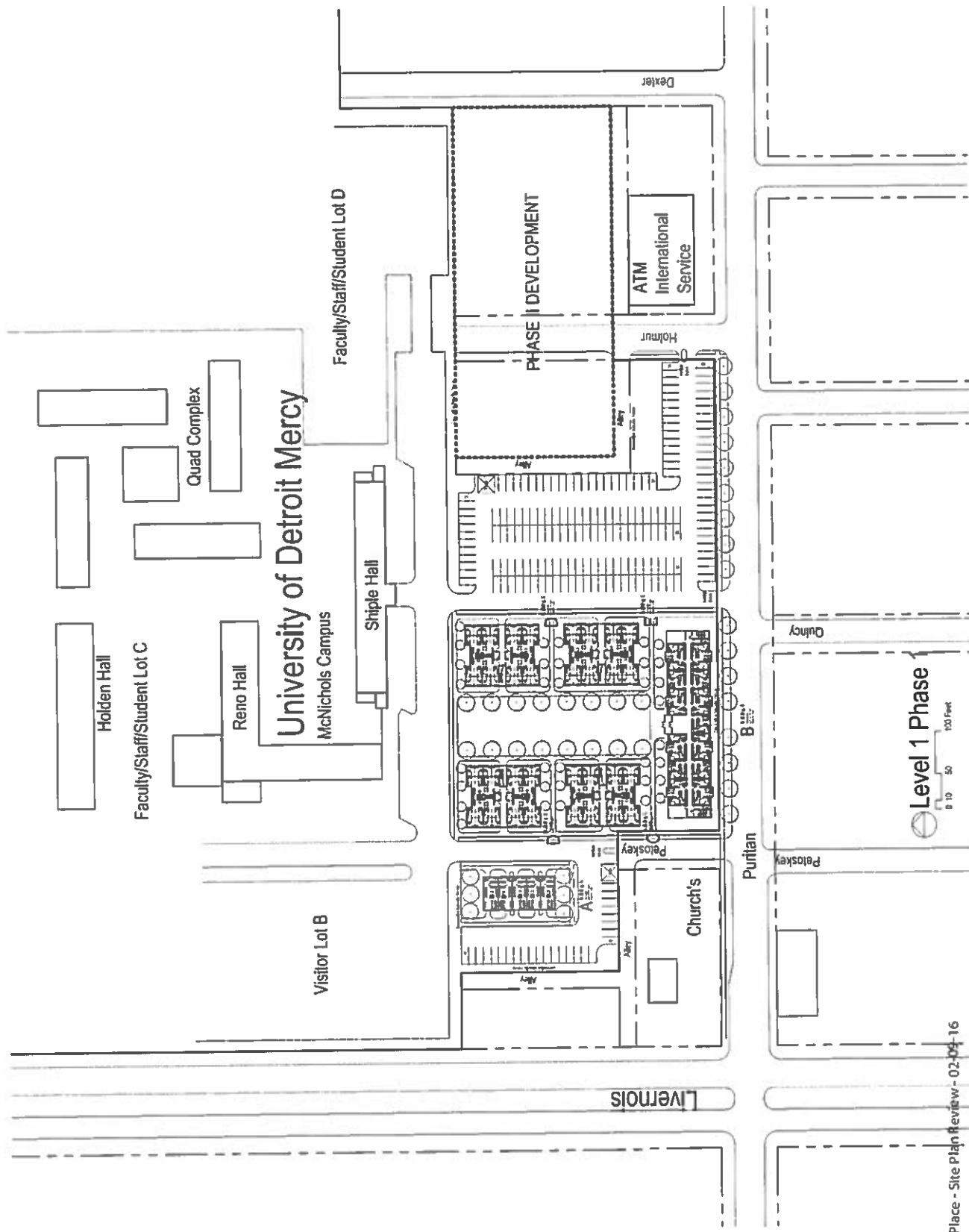


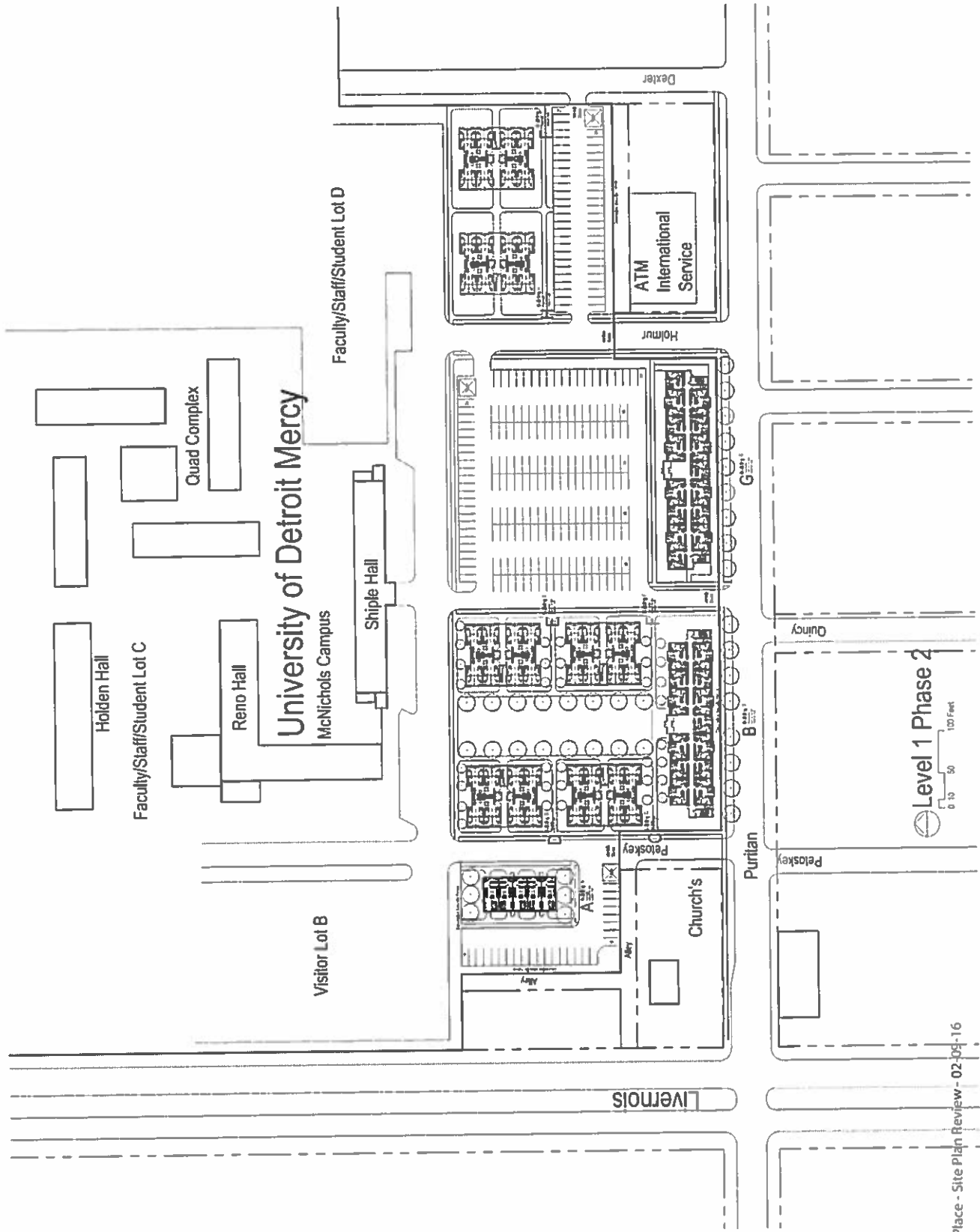


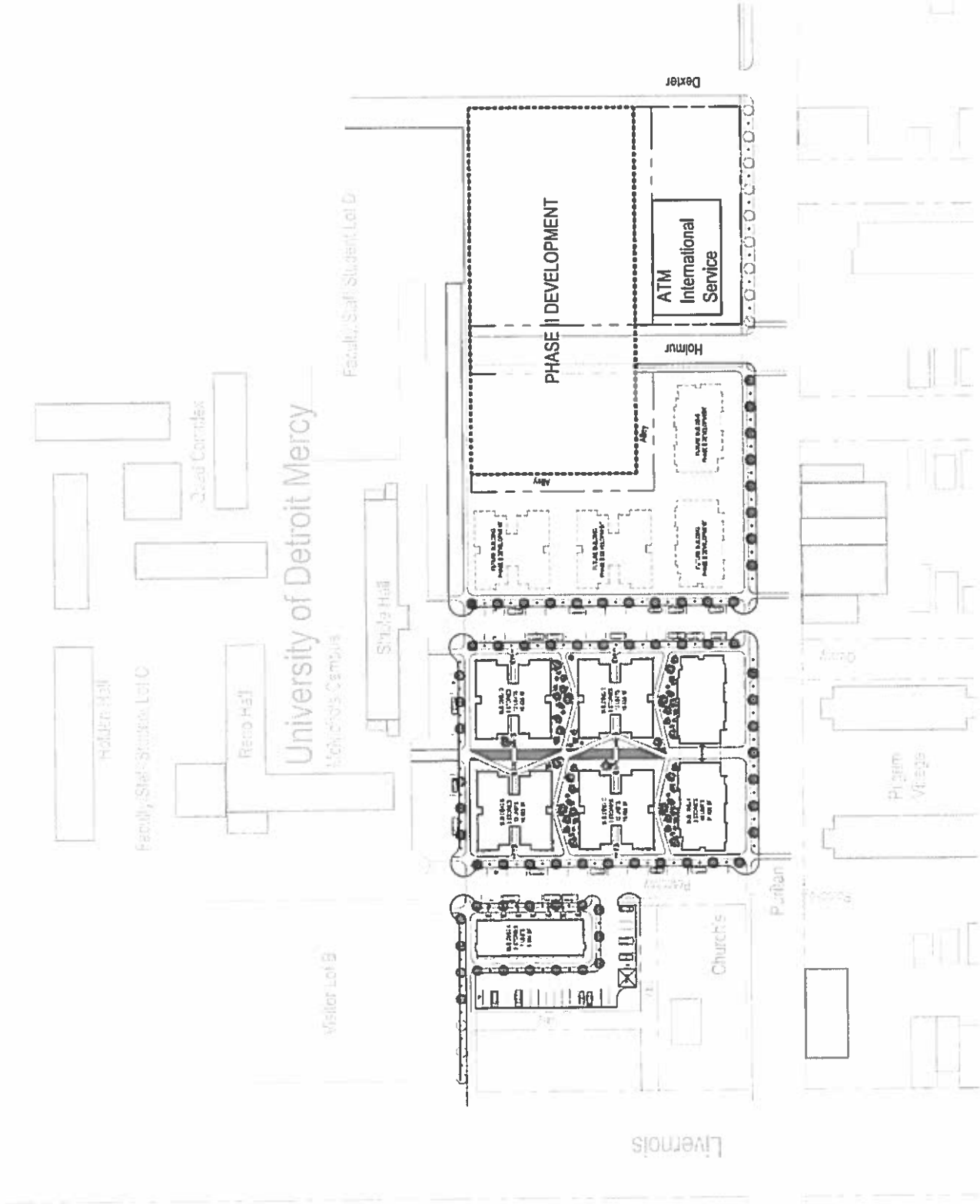


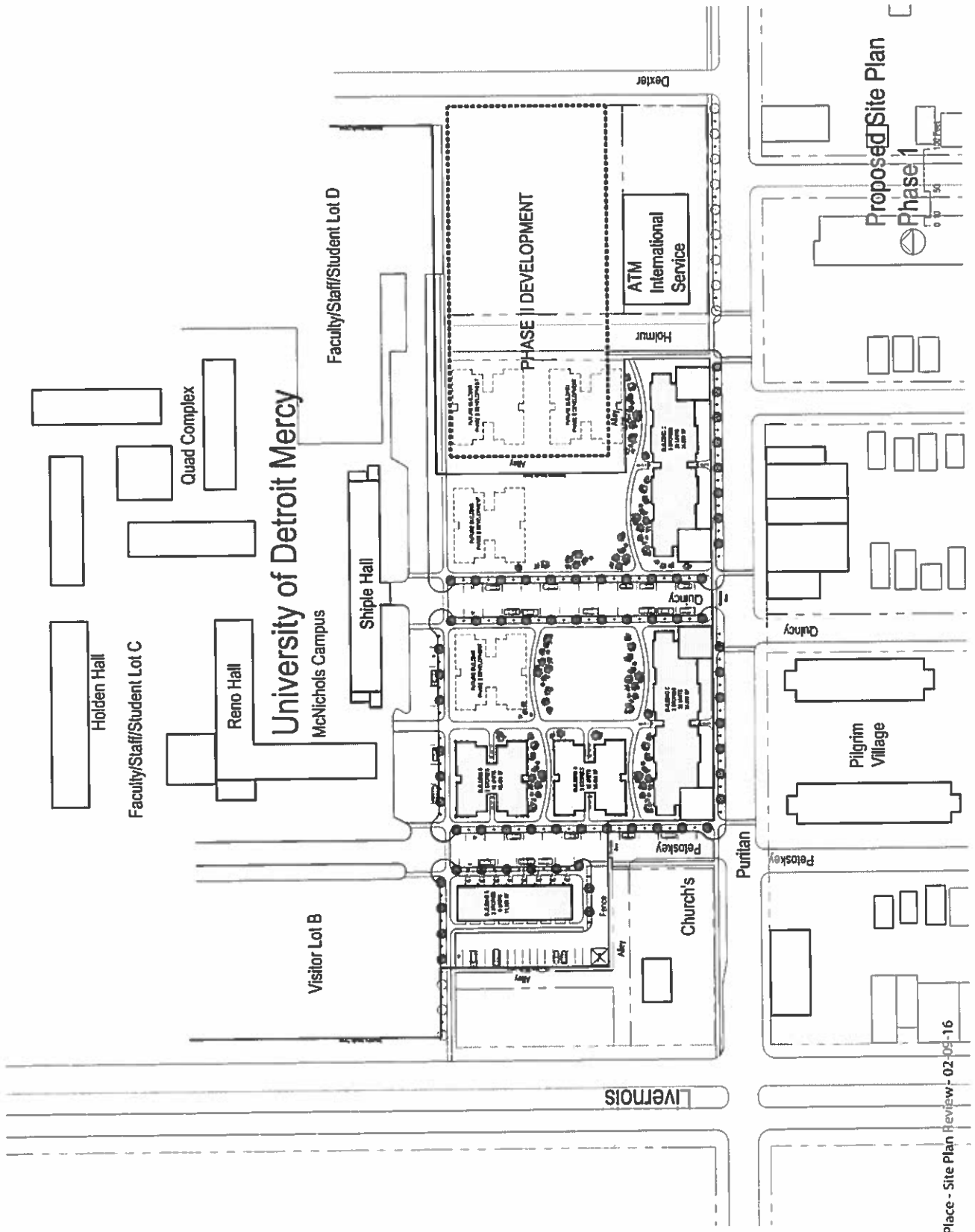






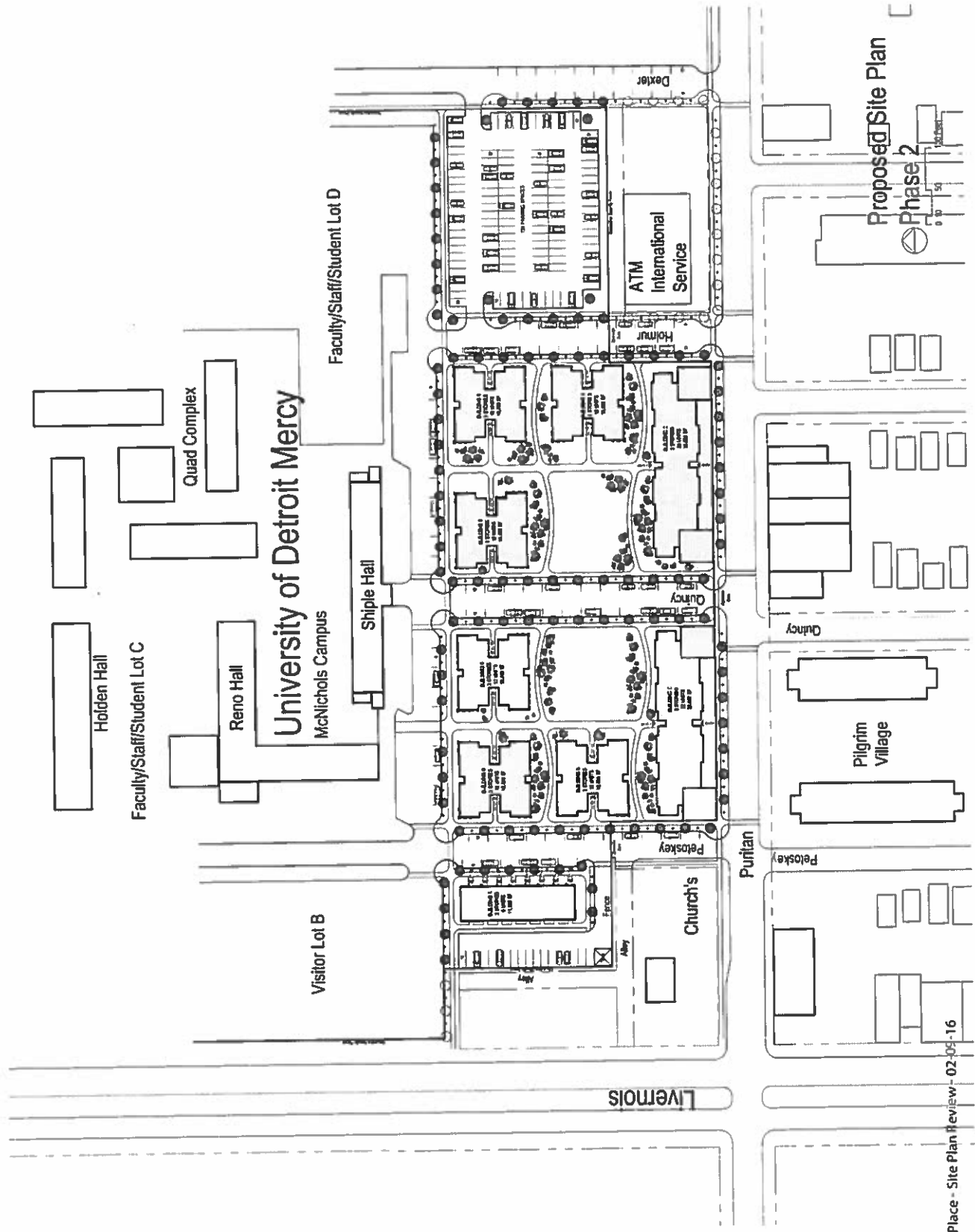


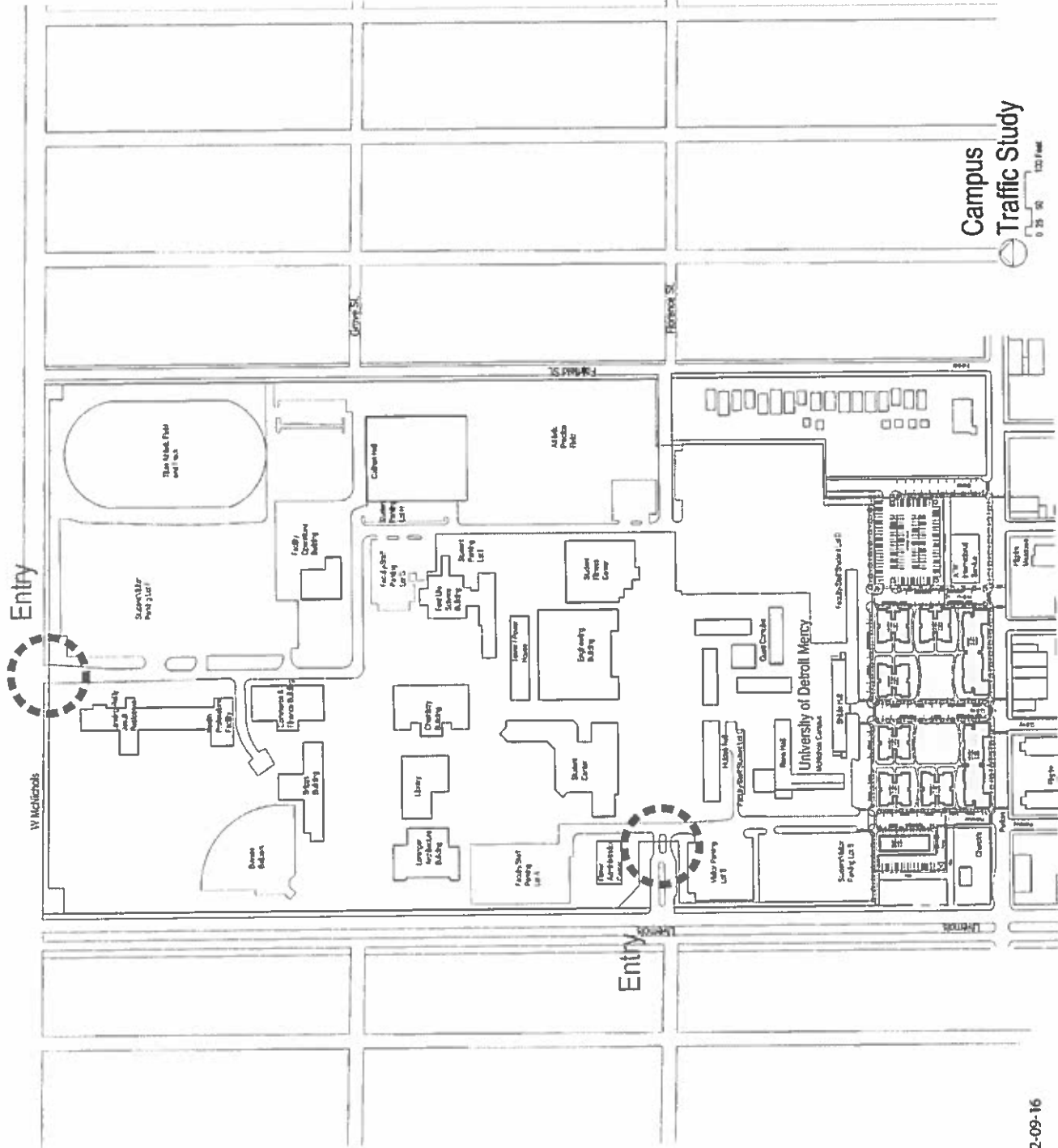

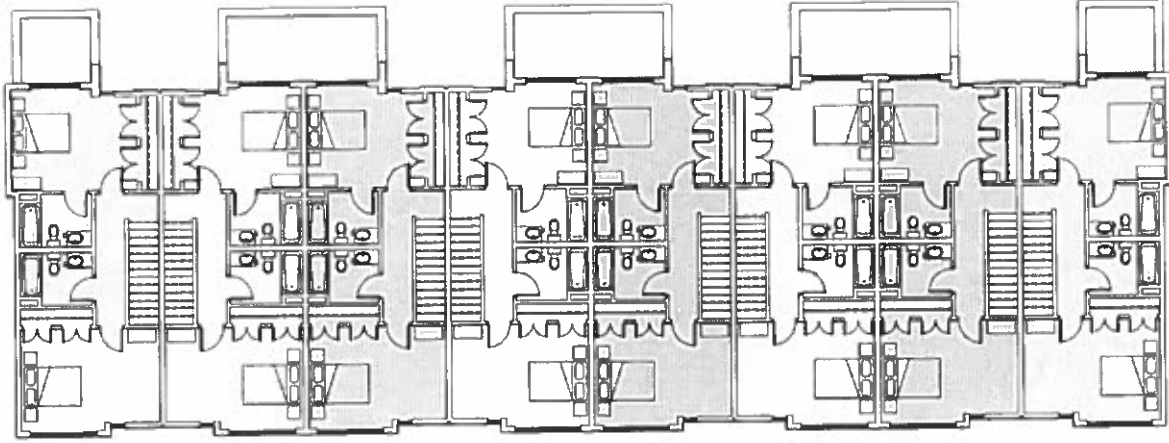

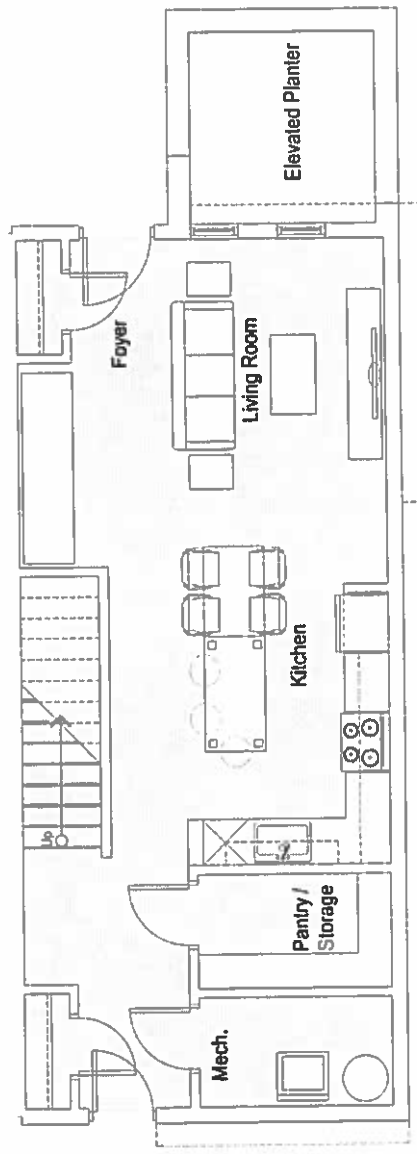
Building A

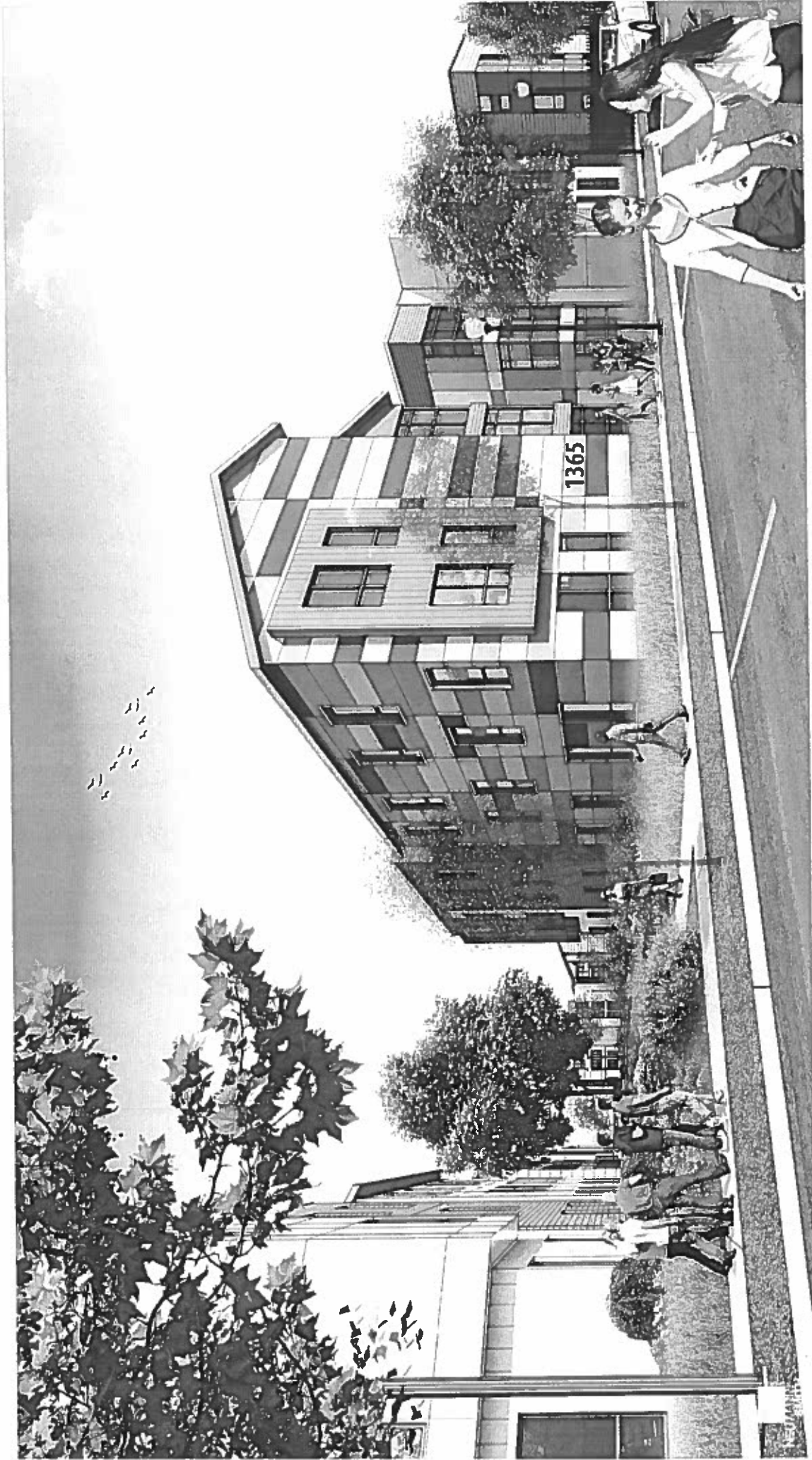

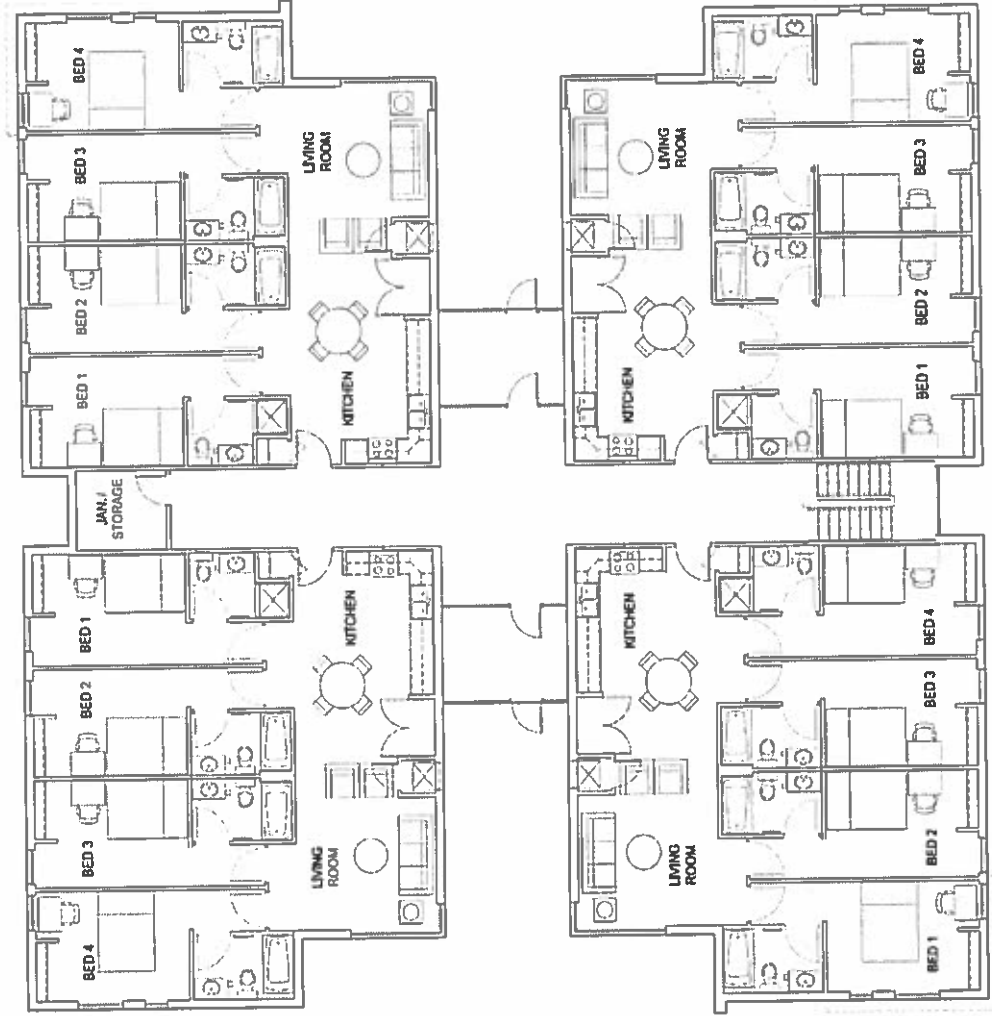

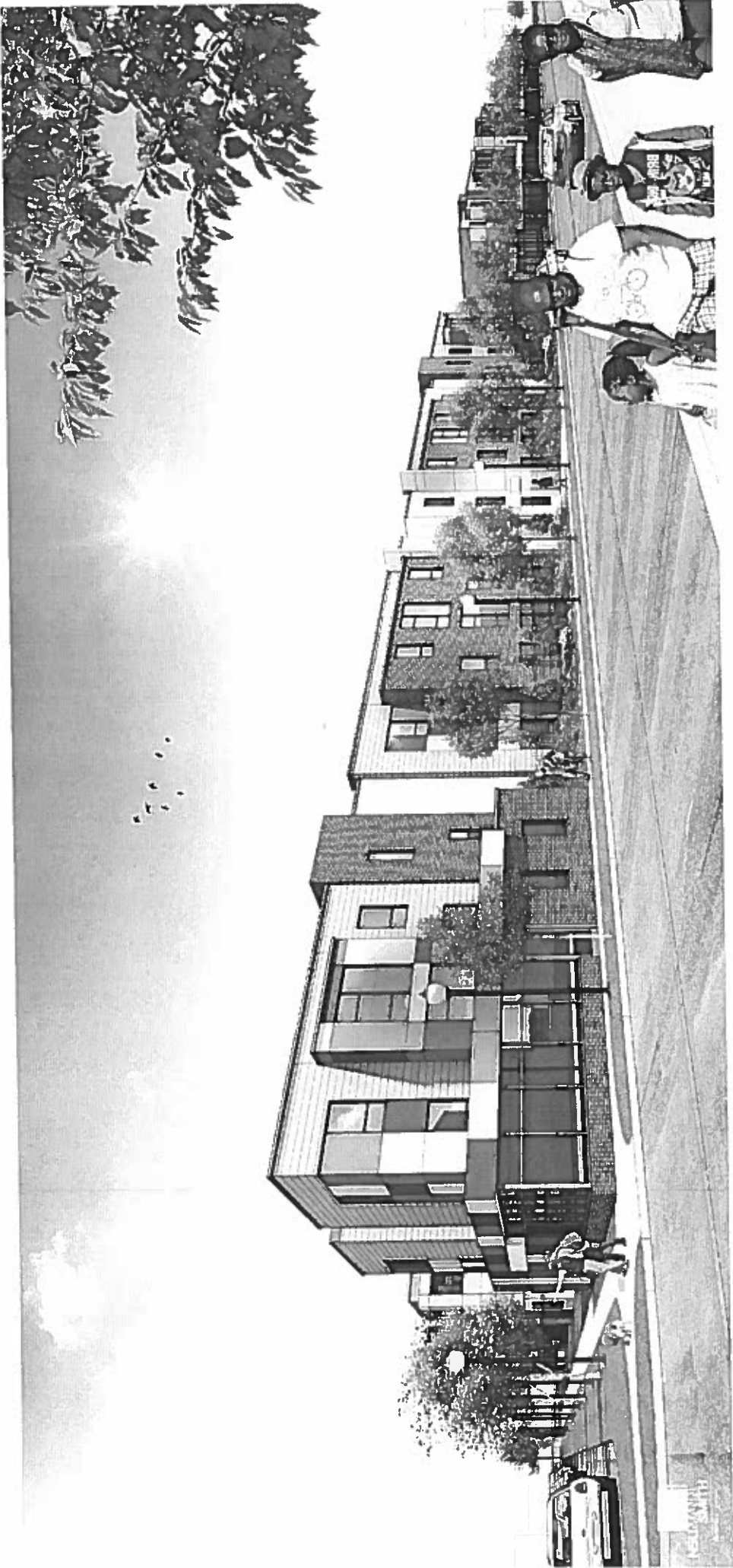


**BUILDING B**
