

Intersection Consulting Group, LLC, on behalf of Proactive Logistic Solutions, LLC, 2211 Woodward Avenue, Detroit, MI 48201, respectfully requests that the City of Detroit vacate the following public rights-of-way:


- An outright vacation of the Park Avenue right-of-way, 60 feet wide, between Henry Street and Fisher Service Drive, 170.86 feet in length, for public vehicular, pedestrian and utility purposes and that concurrent with the vacation the property owner will grant easements for existing utilities.
- A 2.5 foot wide subsurface vacation of the easternmost side of public alley right-of-way first east of Clifford Street, beginning at the northeast corner of Fisher Service Drive and the public alley and extending north 170.86 feet in length.
- A 0.5 foot wide subsurface vacation of the southernmost Henry Street right-of-way, beginning at the southwest corner of Henry Street and Park Avenue and extending west 247.5 feet in length.

All vacations are bounded by Park Avenue, Henry Street, Clifford Street, and Fisher Service Drive. The limits of the vacations can be found in the attachment, enclosed herein.

Giffels Webster has been asked to facilitate the requested vacations in conjunction with Intersection Consulting Group LCC. We will be working with the City of Detroit's Department of Public Works – City Engineering Department, and stakeholders to achieve vacations that are satisfactory to all interested parties. PROVISIONS FOR ENCROACHMENT For Petition 1444

Detroit Water and Sewerage (DWSD) agree to the proposed encroachment subject to the fulfilling of the following provisions:

- 1. By approval of this petition the (DWSD) does not waive any of its rights to its facilities located in the right of way, and at all time, DWSD, its agents or employees, shall have the right to enter upon the right of way to maintain, repair, alter, service, inspect, or install its facilities. All costs incident to the damaging, dismantling, demolishing, removal and replacement of structures or other improvements herein permitted and incurred in gaining access to DWSD's facilities for maintenance, repairing, alteration, servicing or inspection caused by the encroachment shall be borne by the petitioner. All costs associated with gaining access to DWSD's facilities, which could normally be expected had the petitioner not encroached into the right of way shall be borne by DWSD.
- 2. All construction performed under this petition shall not be commenced until after five (5) days written notice to DWSD. Seventy-two (72) hours notice shall also be provided in accordance with P.A. 53 1974, as amended, utilizing the MISS DIG one call system.
- 3. Construction under this petition is subject to inspection and approval by DWSD forces. The cost of such inspection shall, at the discretion of DWSD, be borne by the petitioner.
- 4. If DWSD facilities located within the right of way shall break or be damaged as the result of any action on the part of the petitioner, then in such event the petitioner agrees to be liable for all costs incident to the repair, replacement or relocation of such broken or damaged DWSD facilities.
- The petitioner shall hold DWSD harmless for any damage to the encroaching device constructed or installed under this petition, which may be caused by the failure of DWSD's facilities.

Detroit Water & Sewerage Department Provisions for Relocation Due to Vacation for Petition No 1444

Provided that the petitioner shall design and construct proposed sewers and to make the connections to the existing public sewers as required by the Detroit Water and Sewerage Department (DWSD) prior to construction of the proposed sewers,

Provided that the plans for the sewers shall be prepared by a registered engineer; and further

Provided that DWSD be and is hereby authorized to review the drawings for the proposed sewers s and to issue permits for the construction of the sewers, and further

Provided that the entire work is to be performed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by DWSD and constructed under the inspection and approval of DWSD; and further

Provided that the entire cost of the proposed sewers construction, including inspection, survey and engineering shall be borne by the petitioner; and further

Provided that the petitioner shall deposit with DWSD, in advance of engineering, inspection and survey, such amounts as the department deems necessary to cover the costs of these services; and further

Provided that the petitioner shall grant to the City a satisfactory easement for the sewers; and further

Provided that the Board of Water Commissioners shall accept and execute the easement grant on behalf of the City; and further

Provided, that the petitioner shall provide DWSD with as -built drawings on the proposed sewers; and further

Provided that the petitioner shall provide a one (1) year warranty for the proposed sewers; and further

Provided that upon satisfactory completion, the sewers shall become City property and become part of the City system. And any existing sewers that were abandoned shall belong to the petitioner and will no longer be the responsibility of the City.
