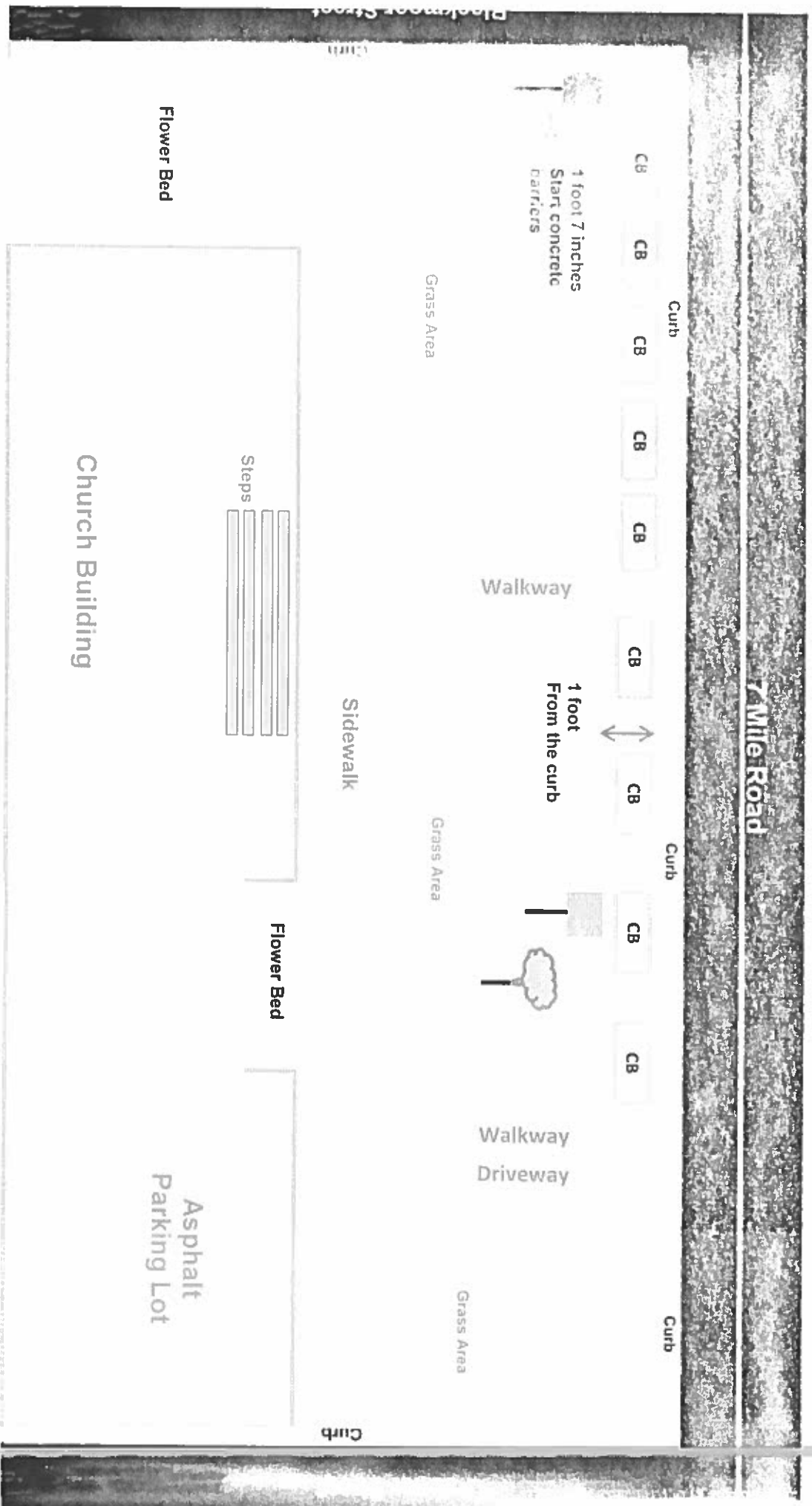


Highland Church of Christ Concrete Barriers
