Meena,

To follow up on our conversation, we revised our petition sketch to conform to the zoning ordinance (attached). We reduced the above grade encroachment to start 8.5 feet above grade and extend out ½ between the curb face and right-of-way.

The only exception is the tenant's "Ready Player One" (RPO) sign that has already been installed, see attached photo. This sign was permitted by BSEED, installed and accepted by BSEED, see attached RPO City Approval PDF.

Just for the area around the sign, we show the encroachment extending 6' from the right of way, beyond the ½ sidewalk width. Given we have BSEED approval, its hope TED can allow this and sign off the petition request.
