

Re: Petition to Vacate Streets and Alleys / Detroit Mt. Elliott Real Estate LLC

Ladies and Gentlemen:

Detroit Mt. Elliott Real Estate LLC ["Petitioner"], hereby requests the vacation of the following streets, alleys and related rights of way:

- 1. Newhall Street, from Mt. Elliott Street to the Conrail railroad easement [to the East];
- 2. Heintz Street, from Mt. Elliott Street to Girardin Road;
- 3. Related public alleys between Miller Road and Georgia Street and Newhall Street, and between Mt. Elliott Street and the Conrail railroad easement;

I have attached a drawing to more accurately describe these streets and alleys. All of the parcels adjoining the streets and alleys listed above are owned either by the Petitioner, or the City of Detroit.

This petition is to support a larger project to renovate the 313,000 square foot building located at 8650 Mt. Elliott Street for the benefit of ArcelorMittal Tailored Blanks Americas Corporation ["ArcelorMittal"], our tenant. This renovation is well under way, with occupancy scheduled next month. When completed, ArcelorMittal will operate a state-of-the-art manufacturing facility, serving all major automakers and tier one suppliers, and creating at least 120 jobs.

It should also be mentioned that the Petitioner and the City of Detroit are moving forward with a land swap in which the remaining parcels East of the railroad tracks owned by the City will be purchased by the Petitioner. Once completed, Petitioner will own all the property bounded by the Conrail Railroad tracks, Georgia Street, Miller Street, and Mt. Elliott Street.



The Petitioner requests the vacation of these streets and alleyways, to allow Petitioner's tenant, ArcelorMittal to provide more parking space for their employees, permit a separation of car and truck traffic [for safety], and permit expansion of the facility at a later date.

The Petitioner respectfully requests formal approval of these requests as soon as possible, to allow ArcelorMittal full use of the facility, and insure the safety of its employees.

It is my understanding that this issue should go to the City Council hearing for approval. Please forward this Petition to the appropriate city offices for review and approval by the City Council.
