Request To Outright Vacate Newhall Street with, And Various Alleys In The Area

Bound By Heintz, Georgia, Mt. Elliott Ave., And New York Central Railroad

The Detroit Water and Sewerage Department (DWSD) has received the subject petition. DWSD has water and/or sewer lines located within a 20 foot wide easement for a water main on the site and in the area requested for outright vacation and are comments are as follows

- DWSD has no objections to the requested vacations provided that all of the properties serviced by the water and/or sewer lines in the vacated right of ways are owned by the petitioner and no additional parcels or individuals are affected by the vacation. Furthermore, the petitioner will bulkhead the sewers, take ownership of sewers and DWSD will no longer be liable for the water mains and/or sewers in the vacated right of way.
- The attached provisions for easement and outright vacation must be followed

The entire work is to be performed in accordance with DWSD specifications and standards, with all fees deposited with DWSD, in advance, for the whole amount necessary to cover the costs of permits and inspection.



Re: Revised Petition to Vacate Streets and Alleys / Detroit Mt. Elliott Real Estate LLC,

Ladies and Gentlemen:

Detroit Mt. Elliott Real Estate LLC ["Petitioner"], had submitted a petition to vacate on August 24, 2017 and was assigned #1761 to this request. Due to the complexity of the nature of this petition, DMERE (Petitioner) has revised this petition, reducing the scope of work under this request. A new petition will be submitted under separate cover to address streets and alleys south of the main building located at 8650 Mt. Elliott Street. This revised petition seeks only to vacate streets, alleys and related rights of way in the demised area as described below:

- 1. Newhall Street, from Mt. Elliott Street to the Conrail railroad easement [to the East];
- 2. Related public alleys between Newhall Street and Georgia Street and and between Mt. Elliott Street and the Conrail railroad easement;

I have attached a drawing to more accurately describe these streets and alleys. All of the parcels adjoining the streets and alleys listed above are owned either by the Petitioner, or the City of Detroit.

This petition is to support a larger project to renovate the 313,000 square foot building located at 8650 Mt. Elliott Street for the benefit of ArcelorMittal Tailored Blanks Americas Corporation ["ArcelorMittal"], our tenant. This renovation is well under way, with occupancy scheduled next month. When completed, ArcelorMittal will operate a state-of-the-art manufacturing facility, serving all major automakers and tier one suppliers, and creating at least 120 jobs.

It should also be mentioned that the Petitioner and the City of Detroit are moving forward with a land swap in which the remaining parcels East of the railroad tracks owned by the City will be purchased by the Petitioner. Once completed, Petitioner will own all the property bounded by the Conrail Railroad tracks, Georgia Street, Miller Street, and Mt. Elliott Street.



The Petitioner requests the vacation of these streets and alleyways, to allow Petitioner's tenant, ArcelorMittal to provide more parking space for their employees, permit a separation of car and truck traffic [for safety], and permit expansion of the facility at a later date.

The Petitioner respectfully requests formal approval of these requests as soon as possible, to allow ArcelorMittal full use of the facility, and insure the safety of its employees.

It is my understanding that this issue should go to the City Council hearing for approval. Please forward this Petition to the appropriate city offices for review and approval by the City Council.



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

Detroit Water & Sewerage Department Provisions for Relocation Due to Vacation for Petition No. 1761

Provided that the petitioner shall design and construct proposed sewers and or water mains plus make the connections to the existing public sewers and or water mains as required by the Detroit Water and Sewerage Department (DWSD) prior to construction of the proposed sewers and or water mains,

Provided that the plans for the sewers and or water mains shall be prepared by a registered engineer; and further

Provided that DWSD be and is hereby authorized to review the drawings for the proposed sewers and or water mains and to issue permits for the construction of the sewers and or water mains, and further

Provided that the entire work is to be performed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by DWSD and constructed under the inspection and approval of DWSD; and further

Provided that the entire cost of the proposed sewers and or water mains construction, including inspection, survey and engineering shall be borne by the petitioner; and further

Provided that the petitioner shall deposit with DWSD, in advance of engineering, inspection and survey, such amounts as the department deems necessary to cover the costs of these services; and further

Provided that the petitioner shall grant to the City a satisfactory easement for the sewers and or water mains; and further

Provided that the Board of Water Commissioners shall accept and execute the easement grant on behalf of the City; and further

Provided, that the petitioner shall provide DWSD with as -built drawings on the proposed sewers and or water mains; and further

Provided that the petitioner shall provide a one (1) year warranty for the proposed sewers and or water mains; and further

Provided that upon satisfactory completion, the sewers and or water mains shall become City property and become part of the City system. And any existing sewers or water mains that were abandoned shall belong to the petitioner and will no longer be the responsibility of the City.

PROVISIONS FOR EASEMENT

1. An easement, is reserved for the Detroit Water and Sewerage Department for the purpose of installing, maintaining, repairing, removing, or replacing any sewers, water mains, fire hydrants and appurtenances, with the right of ingress and egress at any time to, and over said easement for the purpose above set forth.


Free and easy access to the sewers, water mains, fire hydrants and manholes and structures within the easement is required for Detroit Water and Sewerage Department equipment, including the use of backhoes, bull dozers, cranes or pipe trucks, and other heavy construction equipment, as necessary for the alteration or repair of the sewer or water main facilities.

The Detroit Water and Sewerage Department retains the right to install suitable permanent main location guide posts over its water mains at reasonable intervals and at points of deflection.

- Said owners of the adjoining property, for themselves, their heirs and assigns, agree that no building or structure of any nature whatsoever, including fences, porches, patios, balconies, etc., shall be built upon or over said easement, or that no grade changes or storage of materials shall be made within said easement without prior written approval and agreement with the Detroit Water and Sewerage Department.
- 3. If at any time in the future, the owners of any lots abutting on said easement shall request the removal and/or relocation of the aforementioned utilities in said easement, such owners shall pay all costs incident to such removal and/or relocation. It is further provided that if sewers, water mains, and/or appurtenances in said easement shall break or be damaged as a result of any action on the part of the owner, or assigns, then in such event, the owner or assigns shall be liable for all costs incident to the repair of such broken or damaged sewers and water mains, and shall also be liable for all claims for damages resulting from his action.

These provisions shall be made part of the City Council's Vacating Resolution.
